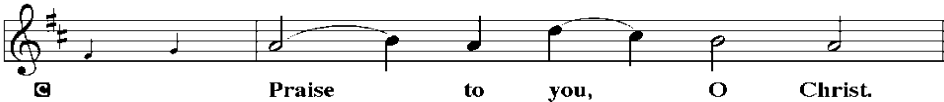

NICENE CREED
