While eating lunch at a fast food restaurant years ago, I saw a pickup truck pull into the parking lot. A man and woman got out and took a second to pet a beautiful Labrador Retriever that was riding in the bed. As the couple walked away, the dog trained his eyes on his masters. He didn't bark. He didn't seem at all restless or nervous. He just fixed his eyes on the front door of the restaurant. The couple calmly ate their meal without giving a second thought to the pet that was patiently awaiting their return.
