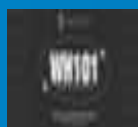

## ADULT BIBLE CLASSES (9:45-10:30AM)

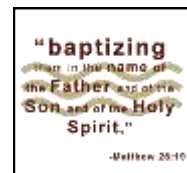
