② What You Say

“This week, during our Missions Rotation, we get the chance to learn about an amazing organization called feedONE Kids, part of a bigger group called Convoy of Hope. They believe that every kid matters—and that no matter how young you are, you can be a world changer!

“These people are all about making sure kids around the world don’t go hungry. Did you know that millions of kids across the globe don’t have enough food. Not just “I forgot to pack a snack” hungry. We’re talking “I don’t know when I’ll eat again” hungry. Sometimes this takes place in other countries, but sometimes it happens right here at home. If you or someone you know doesn’t have food, you can tell us and we can help.

Here’s the good news: feedONE Kids steps in to help change that. They make sure kids around the world get healthy meals, go to school, and know they’re loved.

“And guess what? We can be a part of that! That’s right. God can use you in BIG ways to make a difference in someone’s life now, not just when you’re a grown-up.

“Let’s watch this video to learn more about feedONE Kids and how we can help change the world one meal at a time!”

① What You Do

1. Hand out a feedONE Kids Activity Page to each child.
2. Tell the kids they will get a sticker on their goal bowl for every 50 cents they bring in. (Every 50 cents = 1 meal)
3. Help each child develop a personal goal of how many kids they want to help feed. Have them write it on their sheet in the blank next to "My Goal Bowl."
4. Help them set realistic goals, but it's important to let them set their own goals.
5. Instruct the kids to color and decorate their sheets.
6. Explain that they can ask neighbors, friends, family, etc., for donations.
7. Collect the goal sheets and hang them on a wall of your group's space or hold on to them for Day 5. Remember to hand out stickers as the kids bring in money.
8. If time allows, groups may play a guessing game in which your leader holds up a popular everyday item to see if the kids know if it costs more or less than \$10. (This is the cost of feeding a kid for a month through feedONE.)
 - Ex: frozen pizza (less), shampoo and conditioner set (more), regular cheeseburger (less).

② What You Say

"I've gotta say, your goals for the week are awesome. Anybody want to share one of your goals with the group? (*Let kids respond.*) That's what I'm talking about. You're ready to make a difference and help feedONE do something amazing.

"This week, we get the chance to bring money that could actually change a kid's life. That's not just cool. That's powerful.

"Today we learned that **[Bottom Line]** Jesus is the way. Following Him is the most important thing we can ever do. And when we follow Him, He teaches us how to care for others.

"In our Bible story today, Jesus' friends, who were fishermen, dropped everything and followed Him. Jesus gave them a new mission. He told them they'd learn how to fish for people instead. That means sharing what they had been given, and helping others find hope in Jesus too.

"We can share that same hope in Jesus with others, too. We get to share it with people who need it.

"This is going to be a full-on team effort. I'm pumped to get started. You can even ask your family, friends, or neighbors if they want to help feed a kid, too.

"This week, we're on a Kingdom Quest to live like Jesus. And every good quest has someone who needs saving. So, let's step up. Let's help feed kids and show them how much Jesus loves them."

② What You Say

“Yesterday we kicked off our mission with feedONE. They’re helping kids all over the world get the food they need and a shot at a better future. Pretty awesome, right?”

“Today we get to check out one of the countries where they’re making a big impact. And we’re going to meet one of the kids they’re helping.”

1. Hand out yesterday's feedONE Goal Bowl Activity Pages to each child. For new children in your small group, give them a sheet, allow them to decorate it, and explain the sticker system. Help them set a goal for the week and explain why generosity is impactful.
2. Check in with each child about the support they have raised and give them one sticker per 50 cents raised. (Every 50 cents = 1 meal)
3. Encourage kids to keep bringing in change this week to "fill their bowl." Remind the group they can ask neighbors, friends, family, etc., to donate as well.
4. Collect the goal sheets and hang them on a wall of your group's space or hold on to them throughout the week. Remember to continue to hand out stickers as the kids bring in their change.
5. Hand out a Day 2 – Kenya Coloring Page to each child.

② What You Say

"Today we learned that **[Bottom Line]** Jesus is with me. That's not just a nice thought, it's the truth! Jesus is always with us, just like He was with Peter when Peter stepped out onto the water. Now, let's be real. Walking on water? That sounds wild. And scary. But Peter didn't have to freak out, because Jesus was right there with him.

"Sometimes Jesus asks us to do hard things too. Like giving up something we have to help someone else. That's not always easy. But we don't have to be afraid. Jesus is with us, and He takes care of us while we take care of others.

"Remember Joseph from Kenya? His life changed for the better when he started receiving meals through feedONE. That one simple gift made a huge difference.

"And now, we get the chance to do that for someone else. A kid just like you could be helped because of what you give this week.

"I can't wait to see how you guys step up and crush your goals. This is going to be awesome."

② What You Say

“This week, we’ve been learning all about feedONE and how we get to be part of what they’re doing. Yesterday on our Kingdom Quest, we watched videos about Kenya and heard Joseph’s story. His life changed when he started getting meals at school. Pretty amazing, right?”

“Today we’re going to take it even further. We’re going to find out why feedONE matters so much and why the money you bring in this week is a really big deal.

“Let’s keep the adventure going and meet a new friend. His name is Manny.”

“Did you catch what Manny said? ‘Helping people is important.’

“Now think about this. What if the only way you could eat today was by going to school? That’s what life is like for a lot of kids around the world. That’s why what you’re doing this week matters so much.

② What You Say

What You Need

① What You Do

1. Select one leader to stand in front of all the small groups and present the information below to introduce and conclude the video.
2. If you are unable to view the videos during the lesson, each Small Group Leader can view the videos beforehand and share the information given with the children in their small group.

② What You Say

① What You Do

1. Hand out the feedONE Goal Bowl Activity Pages to each child.
2. Check in with each child about the support they have raised and give them one sticker per 50 cents raised. Congratulate them on their hard work and encourage them to continue raising support to feed more children. They can bring it in anytime or have their parents give online. Tell them to hang the sheet somewhere in their house as a reminder of their impact this week!
3. Pass out blank cards or sheets of paper.
4. Help kids make thank-you cards for neighbors, friends, and family who helped them reach their goals. Encourage creativity and thankfulness. Suggest sample phrasing such as: "Thank you for feeding kids like Manny or kids in Kenya ..."

② What You Say

“Today we learned that **[Bottom Line]** The Holy Spirit helps me! The Holy Spirit helps us share the good news of Jesus around the world! feedONE helps kids in over 40 countries around the world! God sends each of us to share His love and tell others about Jesus. That can be right here where we live, or like what we’ve done this week by giving to feedONE. Because of the money you brought in, children all around the world will get food, go to school, and learn about the love of Jesus. I’m so proud of all of you and the way you’ve helped kids everywhere in God’s Kingdom!

Let’s celebrate all the awesome things God has done through you this week!

- Use ‘feedONE Celebration Slide’ provided. Total up the amount of money raised and tell them how many meals they gave (every 50 cents = 1 meal) to hungry kids around the world.

Lead them in a fun call-and-response cheer:

- You say: Who are we helping?
- Kids say: KIDS AROUND THE WORLD!
- You say: Why are we helping?
- Kids say: TO SHOW THE LOVE OF JESUS!
- You say: Who made this possible?
- Kids shout: JESUS DID!
