



1. **SERMON REFLECTION: SOMEONE READS THE PASSAGE FIRST:** Then Someone gives a brief (5 minute tops) recap/summary of Sunday's sermon
 - a. **Main Point: *The triune God foreordained and accomplished the gospel.***
 - i. **Introduction:** this will feel like a detour, but it is not.
 - (1) Primary Reason: Romans introductory section includes each Person of the Triune God and thus all 3 are involved in the gospel)
 - (2) Secondary Reason: Our church just launched and it is good to give some foundations. Nothing more foundational than the Trinity
 - ii. **Main Point: *The triune God foreordained and accomplished the gospel.***
 - (1) What is the Trinity?
 - (2) How is the Trinity connected with the gospel that Paul teaches in Romans?
 - (3) Why is the Trinity relevant to our lives?
 - b. **"What convicted/impacted you personally about Sunday's sermon?"** The leader is willing to go first

2. **LEARN: What does this section of scripture teach us?**

Main Point: *The triune God foreordained and accomplished the gospel.*

- a. **1st Point: What is the Trinity?**
 - i. Do you think that it is possible to fully understand the Trinity? Why or why not?
 - ii. Is there a difference between truly knowing God, and fully knowing God? Is either possible? Why or why not?
 - iii. Where do we get all of our knowledge of God? Why or why not?
 - iv. Must we understand scripture to believe it? Why or why not?
 - v. Is the Trinity of God the Father, God the Son, and God the Spirit in the Bible? Explain.
 - vi. How early in Church History can we see the Trinity written about? What does that mean to us?
 - vii. How would you define the Trinity?
 - viii. What mistake to all heresies about the Trinity have? Can you give any examples?
- b. **2nd Point: How is the Trinity connected with the gospel that Paul teaches in Romans?**

 - iii. How do you relate to each person of the Trinity? Can you give some concrete examples?
 - iv. What can we learn about the Trinity from 2 Cor 13:14?
3. **Homework/contemplation/meditation:** *What one thing will you do this week share the gospel?*
4. **Closing:** *Praying for one another [use the prayer cards]*
