

5-Day Devotional: Seeing the Lord and Walking in Victory

06/01-05/2026

Day 1: Fix Your Gaze on the Lord

Reading: Isaiah 6:1-8

Devotional: Before we can experience transformation, we must first see the Lord for who He truly is—seated on the throne, clothed in glory, exalted high. Isaiah's vision reminds us that our families, our struggles, and our circumstances need us to fix our gaze on God first. When we see His holiness, we become undone in the best way possible. Our past is erased, our name is changed, and we receive a testimony worth sharing. Today, ask God to show you His glory. Don't let feelings, failures, or fears keep you from seeking Him with all your heart. He promises that when you seek Him wholeheartedly, you will find Him. Fix your gaze upward, and watch everything else come into proper perspective.

Day 2: The Power of Testimony

Reading: Revelation 12:10-11

Devotional: We are overcomers by the blood of the Lamb and the word of our testimony. Your testimony isn't about you—it's about what God has done and who He is. Sometimes we must testify to our enemies, to our circumstances, and even to the person in the mirror. Remind yourself: you're not where you used to be. You've been delivered. When discouragement comes and defeat whispers, let the testimonies of God's faithfulness rise louder. If He did it for others, He'll do it for you. He will bring your prodigal home, change your family, and deliver you from bondage. Your testimony encourages others and strengthens your own faith. Today, speak out loud what God has done and what He's promised to do.

Day 3: Nothing But the Blood

Reading: Hebrews 9:11-14

Devotional: It was the blood—nothing else could wash away our sin and make us whole again. The blood of Jesus is the only thing that makes us holy, righteous, purified, and spotless. It's never been about performance, perfection, or striving for acceptance. Salvation is a gift freely given through Christ's sacrifice. You don't deserve it, you can't earn it, but you can receive it. The blood has power to transform you from the inside out, washing away shame and covering every sin at the feet of the Most High. When you encounter Christ in His presence, everything

changes. You don't walk the same, talk the same, or live the same. Today, thank Jesus for the precious blood that purchased your freedom and rest in the finished work of Calvary.

Day 4: Trusting God Through Every Trial

Reading: Proverbs 3:5-6

Devotional: Trust in God, your Savior, the One who will never fail. He's been the fourth man in the fire time after time. Born of His Spirit and washed in His blood, what He did on Calvary is more than enough. The author of tomorrow has ordered your steps, so you can rest in perfect submission. You may have doubts and fears, your eyes may be filled with tears, but Jesus is the friend who watches day and night. When you go to Him in prayer, He knows every care. Just a little talk with Jesus makes everything right. Walking by faith, not by sight, means trusting His character even when circumstances seem impossible. Today, take your troubles to Jesus in prayer and trust that He hears your faintest cry.

Day 5: Walking Out Your Victory

Reading: 1 Corinthians 15:55-58

Devotional: Victory is yours today! Satan must flee because greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world. The Holy Ghost is yours, the victory is yours, and when this life is over, you'll fly away to a home on God's celestial shore. But don't wait until heaven to walk in victory—walk it out today. Get out of your comfort zone, your 18 inches of real estate, and actively pursue the promises of God. He is your healer, your deliverer, your way-maker, and your chain-breaker. Nothing is impossible with God. He can turn around the irreversible, heal every hurt, and restore what's been broken. The next chapter God is writing is greater than the last. Today, stand to your feet spiritually and walk out your victory with confidence, knowing that Jesus has already won the battle.
