## No Other Name | The Door

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### DINNER & DELIGHT *45 minutes*

- During dinner, share a time you went through the wrong door (literal or metaphorical). Reflecting back, was that a comical experience or was it costly to your soul?

### LEARN & STUDY *20 minutes*

#### Read together: *John 10v1-10*

- What is Jesus trying to relay through the imagery of him being the gate/door?
- What are the three promises of those who “enters through me?” (v. 9) What do these promises suggest about the kind of life Jesus offers both *right now* and *in the future*?
- What does Jesus mean when he says, “I have come so that they may have *life* and have it in *abundance*?”

### PRACTICE & IMPLEMENT *40 minutes*

#### RIGHT NOW:

- Where are you looking for life? Is the gate you’re trusting to lead you to the life you’ve always wanted, delivering on what it promised?
- What gate do you tend to trust instead of Jesus?
  - **Self-invention:** Life is found by looking within, building your own truth, constructing your own identity.
  - **Achievement:** Life is found in success, accomplishment, status, influence, or productivity
  - **Pleasure and consumption:** Life is found through our appetites and desires (more comfort, experiences, sex, entertainment, scrolling, and distraction).
  - **Spirituality:** Life is found in becoming a “better person,” cleaning yourself up, trying harder, going to church, or becoming more respectable.
- Andrew articulated the take home truth as, **only through Jesus can the life you were made for be found.** How is Jesus inviting you to live this out?

#### THIS WEEK:

- Text your community and share one way you chose to trust Jesus as your source of life this week.

### REFLECT & PRAY *15 minutes*

#### Pair up and pray

- What is one takeaway from your time in community today?
- Pray to experience the reality that *only through Jesus can the life you were made for be found.*
