JOIN US FOR 24/7 PRAYER

MAY 31 - JUNE 7, 2026

Emphasis of prayer during this week:

SPIRITUAL RENEWAL: Pray God would renew a right Spirit in you and in our church family.

REACH ONE MORE: Who in your life do you need to pray for who doesn't yet know Jesus?

WHY JOIN?

- Praying for these two themes is an investment in your own spiritual growth and for those lost to be found by Jesus and his grace.

WHO'S INVITED?

- We invite our whole church family to spend an hour (of 168 total hours) praying for personal spiritual renewal and to reach one more with the gospel!

How to spend an hour praying

Use this guide to help you experience a meaningful time with God. As you pray for spiritual renewal and a heart to reach one more, follow these prompts, spending about 5 minutes on each.

Pray for Spiritual Renewal

WAITING: "Wait" and focus your thoughts on God. It's a silent surrender of the soul to God; a time of silent love. Think on God and God alone.

CONFESSION: Ask God to search your heart for unconfessed sin. Confess, repent, and receive God's forgiveness.

LISTENING: Simply say, "Speak, God. I, your child, am listening." Write down what God impresses on your mind as you quietly wait.

REFLECT: Read Romans 12v2. What are you holding back from God? What in your spiritual life needs to be transformed by God? In what ways does your relationship with God need to be renewed?

PETITION: Present the needs of life that, if met, will bring honor to the Lord. Be simple, specific, and sincere in these petitions.

PRACTICE: Ask God to continue to meet you as you encounter him and live into trusting and fully following Jesus.

Pray to Reach One More

PRAISE: Praise God for who he is. Thank him for saving you, and calling you out of darkness into his marvelous light (1 Peter 2v9).

WATCHING: Ask God to open your eyes to the people around you. Ask God to bring to mind someone(s) in your life who is spiritually lost.

PRAYING SCRIPTURE: Read John 3v16-18. As you read, insert the name of the person who is far from God.

INTERCESSION: Intercede for God's work in and around your "one more." Pray for an open heart, for divine encounters, and plead with God for the salvation of their soul.

MISSION: Pray for boldness to share the good news of Jesus with your one more. Pray 2 Timothy 1v7.

PRACTICE: Ask the Holy Spirit to give you opportunities to reach one more in your daily life and for courage to step out in faith and obey by sharing your own story.

DINNER & DELIGHT 45 minutes

- Share what stood out to you from this week's passage and message out of 1 Peter 2v1-10.
- Take-home Truth:** Spiritual maturity is learning to live before the face of God as people formed by Jesus and held by mercy.

WRAP UP & PRAY 10 minutes

- What is one takeaway from your time in community today?
- Continue to pray our themes this week: Spiritual renewal and praying for the lost
