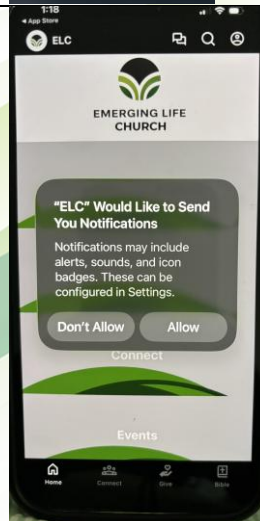


2. Open the Emerging Life Church App on your mobile device.

When prompted, make sure you Allow Emerging Life Church App to send you notifications.



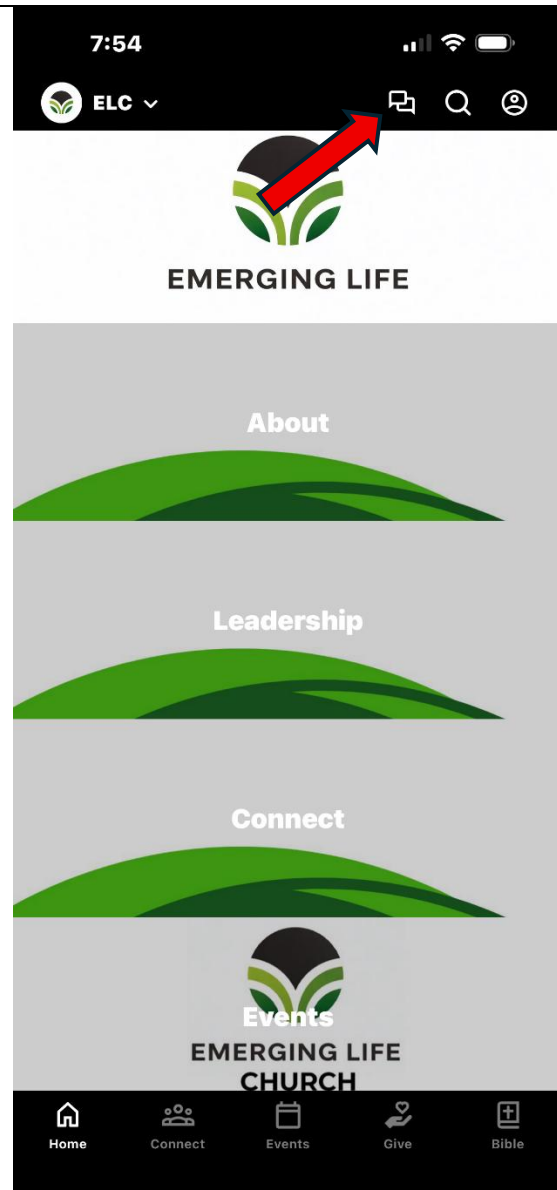

1. From the Home Page, click the Messaging icon in the upper right corner.



2. From the Messaging page, select Conversations and enter your mobile phone number.

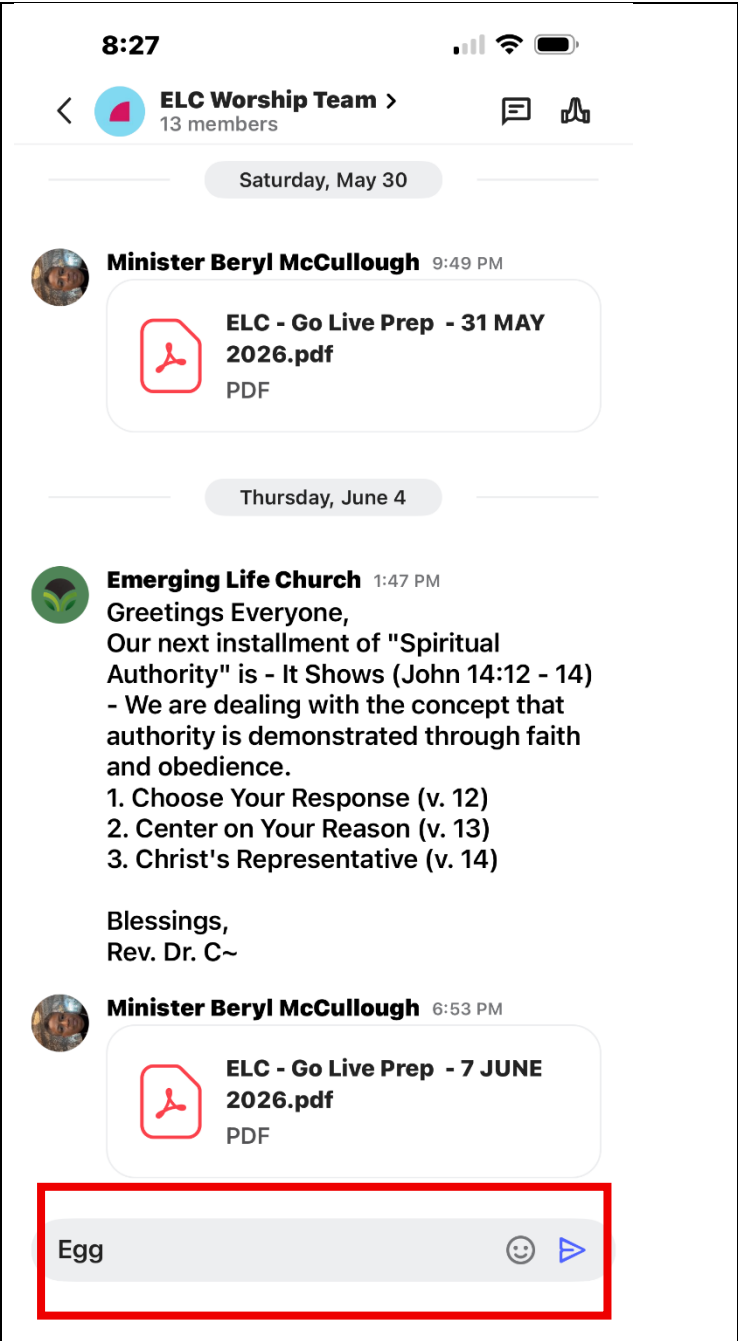
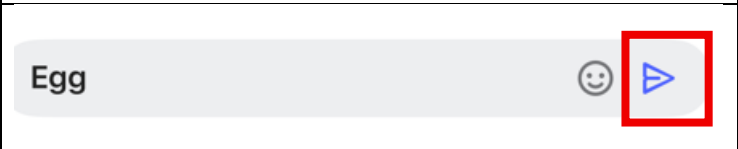
How to Send Messages using SubSplash Messaging on the Church App

To send messages to a group:

1. Select the Group from the list.

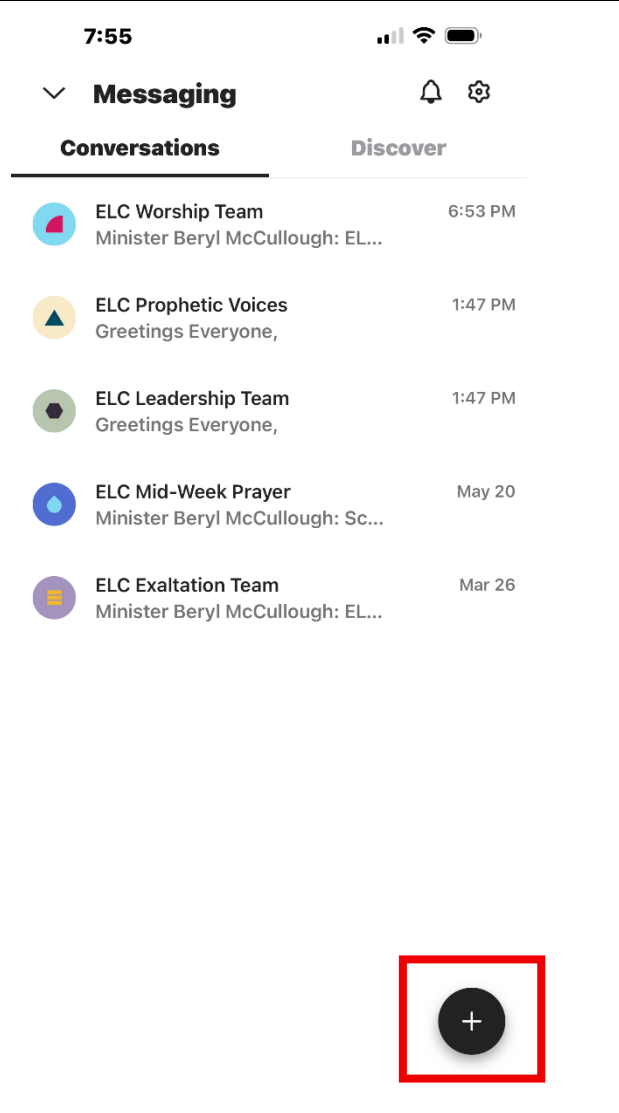
For example, if you want to send a message to the ELC Worship Team, click on the group.

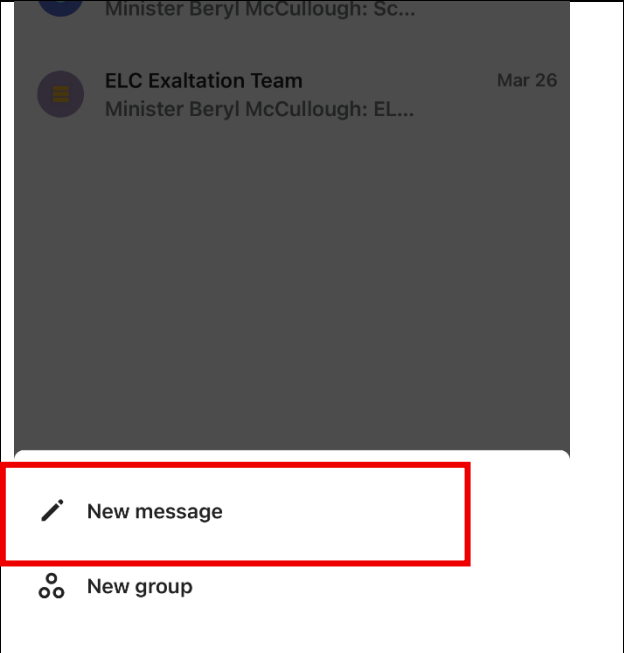
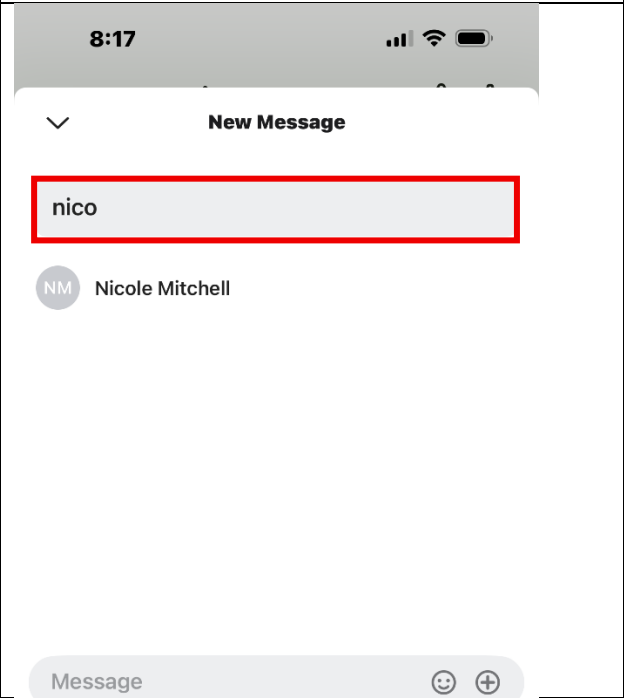


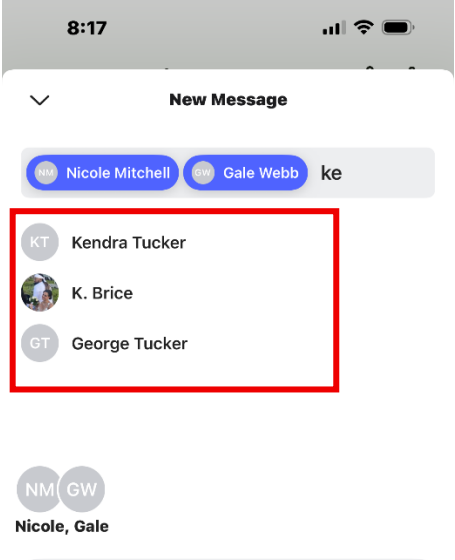
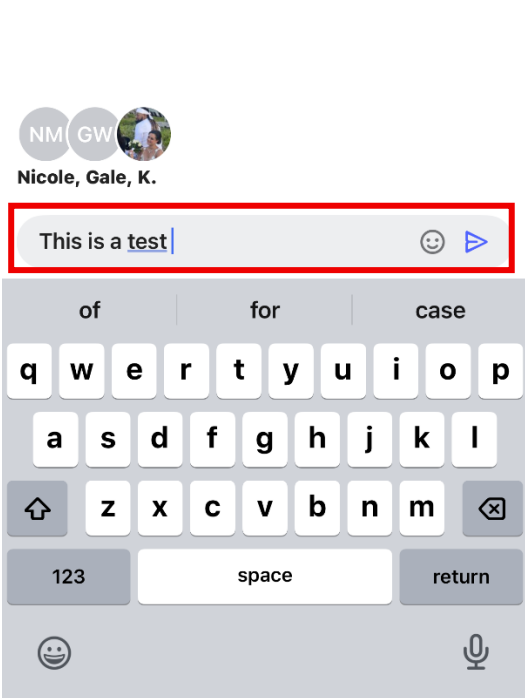
