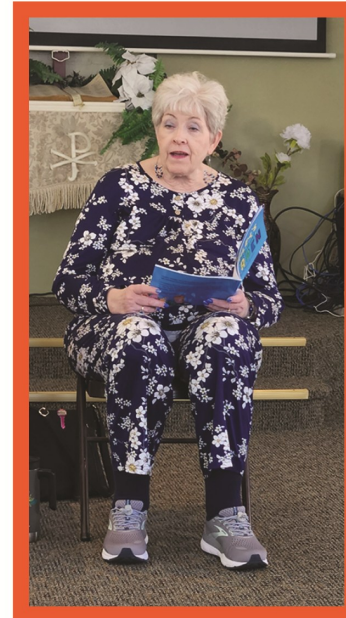


GRACE CHRISTIAN ACADEMY

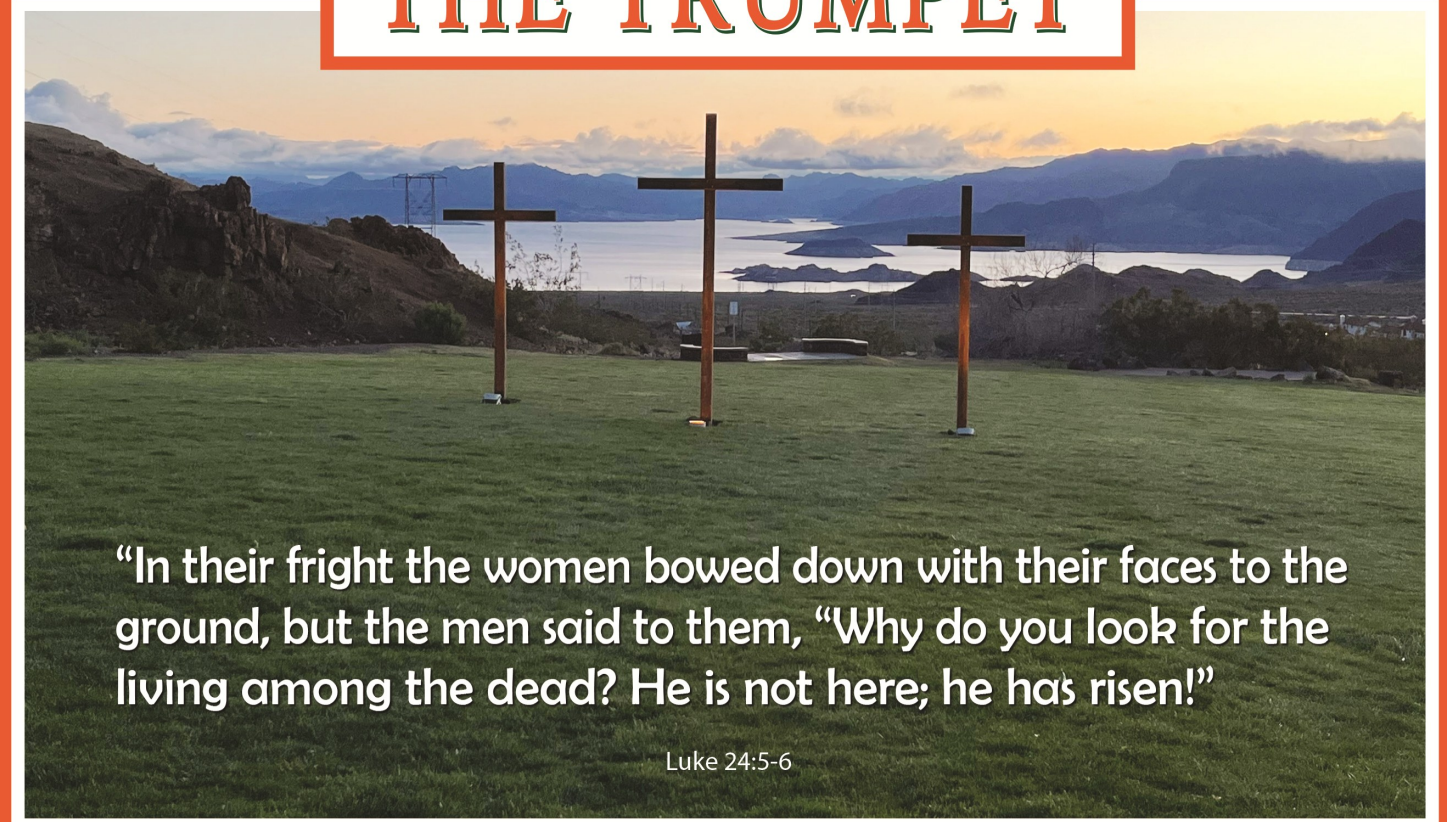


For Giving Grace this month, we are making Easter cards for the residents

Pastor's Corner

A Very Special Easter Memory

Holidays are filled with memories. Not all of them are good but special days of the year tend to stick with us. I remember one Easter dinner my brother (who is now with the Lord) being faced with a dilemma. He was a true momma's boy and flattered my mother every chance he got, but he also adored his wife, it was as if she walked on clouds. At this dinner,

they both made pies. I can occasionally have a mean streak so in front of everyone I asked him, "Howard, whose pie tastes better?" This was a no-win situation for him, but his response was perfect. He said, "They are both delicious" and then he had a second helping of his wife's pie. I thought that was perfect and although this happened so long ago, it is seared in my mind.

One of my favorite Easter memories was about three years after Michel and I were married. We were asked to be in an Easter Sunday morning drama at our church playing the two disciples on the Emmaus Road. You may remember the story. These two individuals are leaving Jerusalem heading back to their home all dejected and very sad, having witnessed the crucifixion of the one they thought was Messiah. While they are walking, the risen Lord starts walking with them, but they are kept from recognizing him.

Our drama began at the back of the church, and we slowly walked up the center aisle. The person of Jesus was played by one of the few men in our church with a beard. As they walk, Jesus leads what must have been the best Bible study ever. (Luke 24:27) "And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he [Jesus] explained to them what was said in all the Scriptures concerning himself." Eventually it looks like this man is about to move on and the two disciples invite him into their home and as Jesus breaks the bread he is recognized and disappears. In verse 32, the two disciples say to each other, "Were not our hearts burning within us while he talked with us on the road and opened the Scriptures to us?"

Here is why that Easter was so memorable. In kind of a miracle, it was no longer Steve and Michel playing parts and the man we knew from church was no longer an ordinary person, but we were the two disciples and that man was Jesus. I can't explain it, but it was one of the most powerful church memories of my life, and as a pastor I have had quite a few. My heart was indeed "burning within me."

Easter is not just a day on the church calendar; it is the heart of the Gospel. Our risen Lord offered us eternal life by believing that his death on the cross is sufficient for all our sins, and even more, he can move our hearts to burn with this wonderful truth.

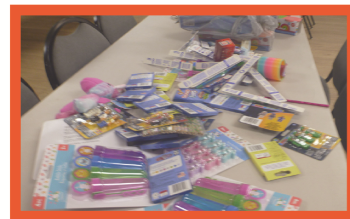
