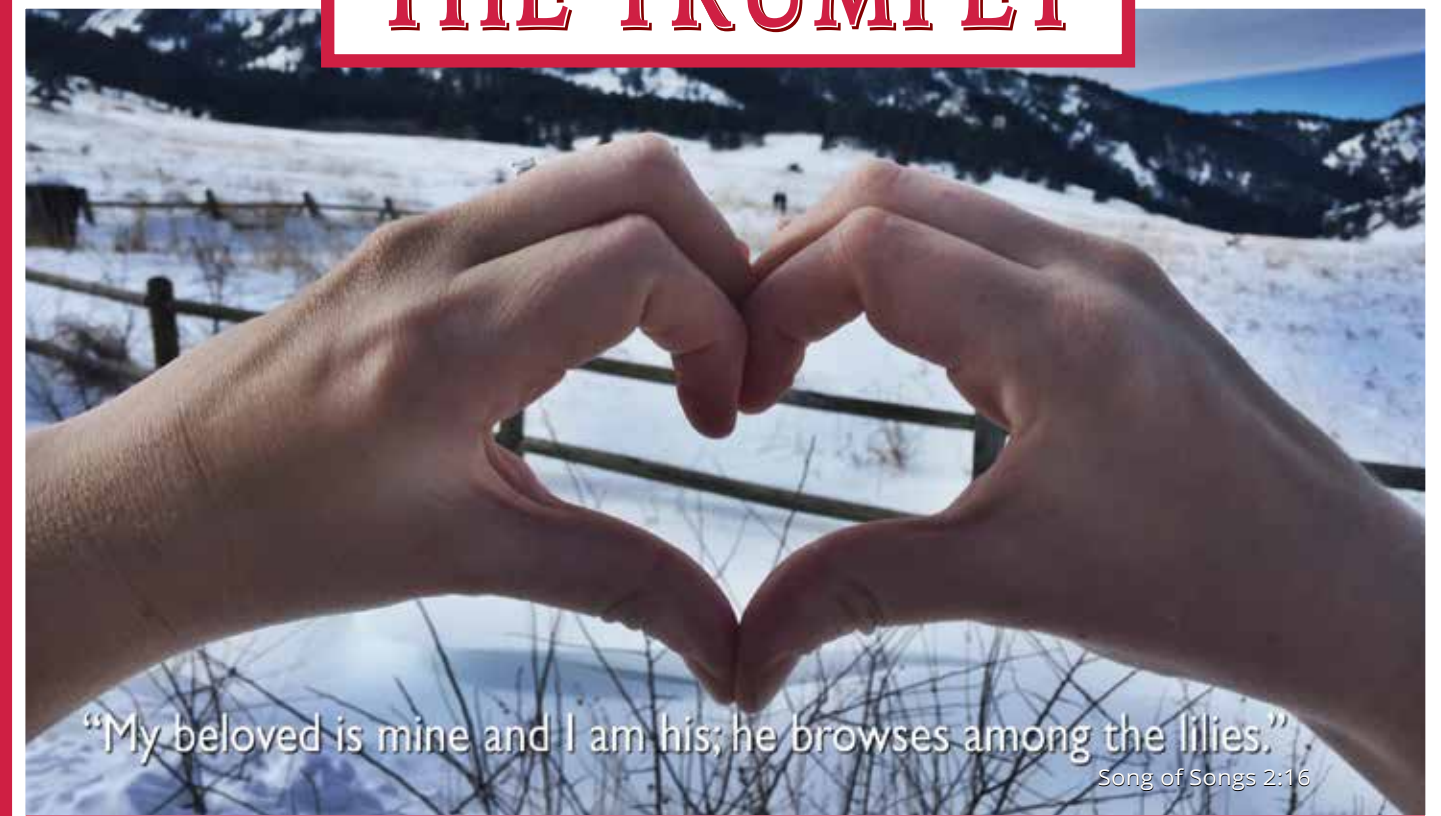

Pastor's Corner

An interview with new Worship Director Napoleon Cummings

Where were you born?

I was born on Staten Island, NY, and lived there until age 17, when I moved to Atlanta to live with my sister. My goal in moving was to go to college, and I ended up at Lee University. My major was Music Education.

What was your family like growing up?

I grew up Catholic, but in reality, we went to a non-denominational Pentecostal church. I am the 6th of 10 kids. Three of us were very musical, and music was a big part of our family life. If we were cleaning, there was music; if we were cooking, there was music. I started singing up front at church when I was ten and soon was playing piano. My first love was singing, but the pastor offered free lessons, and my brother chose to learn drums, and my mother pushed me to the piano.

What connected you to Naturally 7?

I was in college, playing piano, and singing with the "Voices of Lee" (a traveling college group), when I got an unsolicited phone call from Roger Thomas from an A cappella group called Naturally 7. I had never heard of them, and at first I turned them down out of fear, but they called me again, and I took the chance. The touring was hard, but the performing was fun. One example was being in a country like Korea and seeing the impact of the music - the experience was surreal. I almost felt like a passenger in God's plan for my life. I ultimately had 6 passports, and it was before Social Media took hold, so to see the world was such an adventure. Ultimately, I visited 43 countries.

What was it like touring the world with Michael Bublé and Quincy Jones?

You get used to it, but it is powerful to work with people so passionate about music. It was teamwork and even family-like. Quincy, for example, loved to tell stories, and he had so many, like working with Michael Jackson.

How has fatherhood impacted your music?

It did mean that touring had to be limited so I could be a better father. I love that my son loves music also, and he is learning to play the cello. Being a father also meant that I needed to put down roots. That is one of the reasons I am here in Boulder City now.

What drew you to Christ?

The Lord called me at first through my mother and my church, but ultimately it was music that connected my heart to God. I did not have a father present growing up, and music was my conduit to the Lord. As I played, I sensed his presence.

What are you hoping for during your tenure with Grace?

I hope I will be an encouragement for this church to develop a genuine spirit of worship. If I help people see the attributes of God in our worship, I know they will see that God is sufficient to all their needs.

MISSIONS COMMISSION

IT WAS A VERY BUSY YEAR FOR THE MISSIONS COMMISSION!

The Commission selected the recipients for the Easter, Thanksgiving and Christmas special offerings and the response by the Grace Community Church congregation to these was outstanding. Results for the three special offerings were: Easter \$1,829.66; Thanksgiving \$4,309.01 and as of December 31, 2025, Christmas \$2785. From the two Fish offerings for Emergency Aid of Boulder City we collected \$1,214.29 and delivered 12 trunk loads of non-perishable food items.

In other Missions spending this year, Grace Christian Academy received \$7,924 in utility cost. Disbursements for the year from the Missions Commission budget totaled \$27,020 and from the Missions Restricted fund disbursements were \$8,300. Below is a detailed list of these disbursements. Boulder City Senior Center (meals on wheels) \$2,000; Stock a Refrigerator/Pantry \$3,000; Safe House \$1,000; First Choice Pregnancy Services \$2,000; Grace Christian Academy \$5,500 (monies to teachers for classroom supplies 2024-2025 and 2025-2026 school years); SOS Christian Radio Station \$100; Boulder City Senior Center (food pantry) \$2,000; American Red Cross (USA disaster relief) \$2,500; Samaritan's Purse (USA disaster relief) \$2,500; Gift Cards for Bailey Middle School \$2,500; Sumya and Undra support \$8,200; Samaritan's Purse (hurricane relief for Jamaica) \$1,020.
