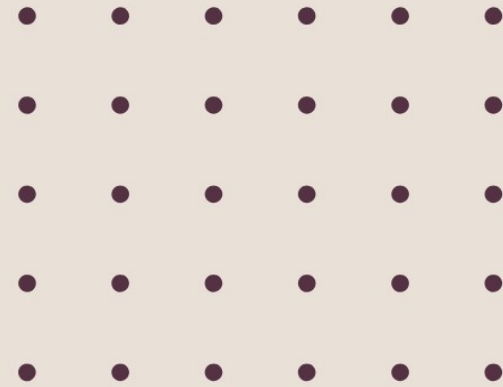

As we gather, my prayer is simple: that God would rekindle the flame within you and strengthen you to walk fully in all He has called you to be and do.

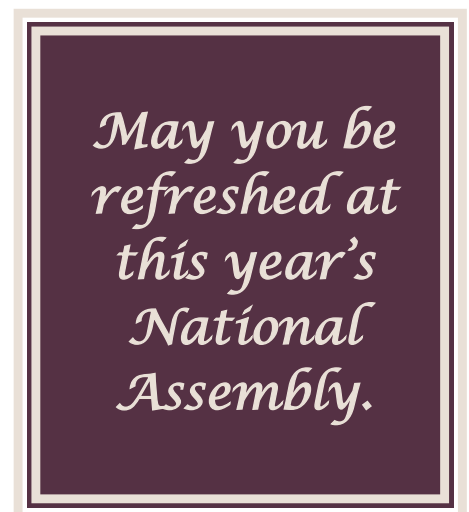
Let’s lean in together with open hearts and expectant faith.

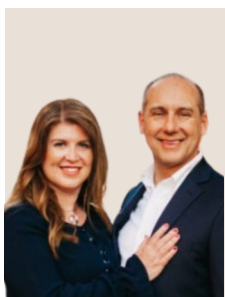

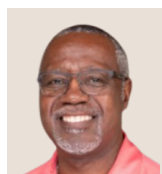

Workflows: Let Automation Take On Your Tasks so You Can Get Back to Ministry

In this session, you will learn how to transition your staff from administrative overload to relational ministry by leveraging the automation within Churchteams. We will dive deep into the workflow feature, demonstrating how to map out and automate repetitive tasks like guest follow-up, volunteer onboarding, and milestone recognition. By the end of the workshop, you'll have a practical blueprint for setting up systems that ensure no one in your community is overlooked. Ultimately, you'll discover how the right tech strategy creates the margin needed for the high-touch, personal care that your people deserve.



Roundabout Renewal

Faith leaders today are navigating significant transitions—changing communities, evolving ministry models, leadership fatigue, and the tension between honoring the past while discerning the future. Yet many leaders lack language for the season they are in. In this workshop, Quincy Brown introduces The Roundabout Way, a biblical and practical framework for understanding seasons of transition through five movements seen throughout Scripture: Egypt, Red Sea, Wilderness, Jordan, and Promised Land.



Closers & Losers: Leadership Pipeline Basics

Ministry leaders can learn how to become “closers” — leaders who close the gap and build a healthy leadership culture that attracts, develops, and retains great people — instead of “losers,” who unintentionally lose future leaders due to a lack of intentional development. 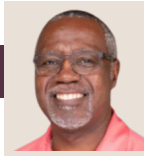

About Harvest Network

Who We Are

Harvest Network is a Christian-ordaining body and network of individual ministers, congregations, and ministries connecting to equip God's workers and reach the world for Christ. We exist to provide not only the practicality of ministerial credentials but also spiritual covering, support, and networking and fellowship opportunities with ministers who walk similar paths.

Harvest Network holds a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status with the federal government and is registered as a faith-based, non-profit corporation. Credentials issued by Harvest Network are recognized by federal and state authorities, hospitals, prisons, and Veterans Affairs organizations.

Harvest Network was formed in the mid-1980s when a group of Spirit-filled Christian leaders from various backgrounds saw the need for a ministerial association that embraced a high view of Scripture, the importance of the gifts of the Spirit being active in the Church today, and a vision of a worldwide harvest.

These three convictions—(1) the Word, (2) the Spirit, and (3) evangelism and missions—remain the foundational values for this association. Harvest Network has today grown to include strong congregations and ministries along with credentialed ministers in the U.S. and dynamic peer-networks overseas. These international networks oversee hundreds of churches and evangelists.

The Harvest Network Logo

The Harvest Network logo symbolizes our partnership with God in producing a harvest of souls. For the past decade, we have used three connecting colored dots to represent the commitment all Harvest Network members share to fulfill Christ's Great Commission in a never-ending cycle of sowing, growing, and going in His name. The brown color represents the seed of the Gospel we sow around the world through evangelism. Moving clockwise, the green color represents our commitment to discipleship, teaching, and equipping all who have been made alive in Christ. The gold color represents a harvest of mature disciples who reinvest themselves in the call to spread the Good News of Christ's Kingdom to the ends of the earth.

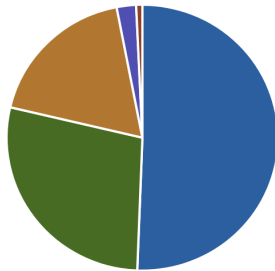

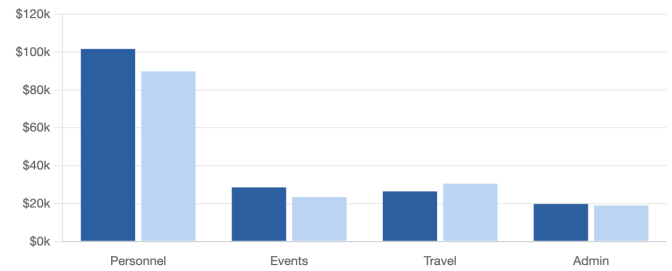
Income sources — 2025–26

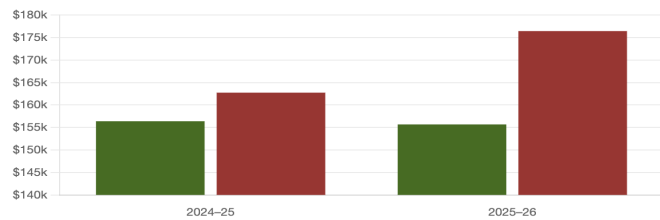
Expenses by category — both years

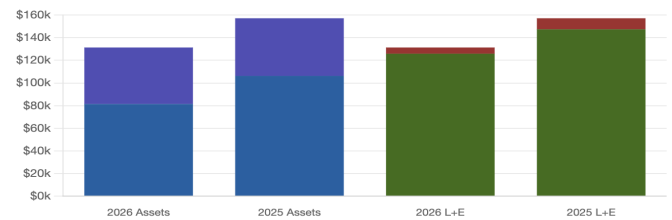
Income vs. expenses — year over year

Income Expenses



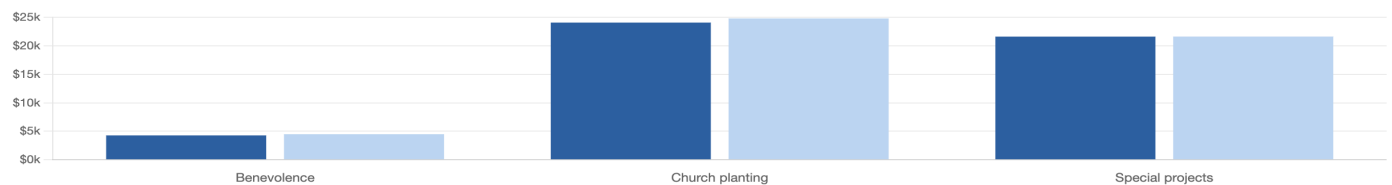
Balance sheet composition — both years
