14 days to Easter

Day 1 — Theme: Longing for Renewal

- Scripture: Psalm 51:10–12
- Prayer: Lord, create in me a clean heart; renew my spirit and draw me nearer to you.
- Practice: Confess one area you need renewal and write a short prayer asking God to begin the work.

Day 2 — Theme: Repentance

- Scripture: 1 John 1:8–9
- Prayer: Father, help me to see honestly where I've missed the mark and to receive your forgiveness.
- Practice: Spend 5–10 minutes silently confessing specific faults; accept God's assurance of forgiveness.

Day 3 — Theme: Humility

- Scripture: Philippians 2:5–8
- Prayer: Jesus, teach me humility—help me to serve others without seeking recognition.
- Practice: Do a small act of service today for someone without telling others.

Day 4 — Theme: Trust

- Scripture: Proverbs 3:5–6
- Prayer: God, increase my trust in you when the way forward is uncertain.
- Practice: Write down a current worry and place it somewhere visible as a reminder to surrender it to God.

Day 5 — Theme: Repentant Heart Toward Others

- Scripture: Matthew 5:23–24
- Prayer: Lord, show me any relationships needing reconciliation; give me courage to reach out.
- Practice: Contact one person for apology, reconciliation, or to offer grace.

Day 6 — Theme: The Word

- Scripture: Hebrews 4:12
- Prayer: Holy Spirit, speak to me through your Word; let it shape my heart & decisions.
- Practice: Read a Gospel chapter, noting one phrase that stands out; meditate on it.

Day 7 — Theme: Prayer and Listening

- Scripture: Psalm 46:10
- Prayer: Father, help me be still and listen for your voice amid the noise.
- Practice: Sit quietly for 10 minutes, listening and journaling any impressions or Scriptures that come.

Day 8 — Theme: Suffering and Compassion

- Scripture: Isaiah 53:3–5
- Prayer: Jesus, you understand suffering—teach me compassion & presence for those in pain.
- Practice: Reach out to someone who's hurting; offer prayer, a call, or a practical help.

Day 9 — Theme: Holiness and Preparation

- Scripture: 1 Peter 1:15–16
- Prayer: Holy God, make me more like you in thought, word, & deed.
- Practice: Identify one habit to adjust for spiritual growth and take a concrete first step.

Day 10 — Theme: Gratitude

- Scripture: 1 Thessalonians 5:16–18
- Prayer: Gracious God, I thank you for your gifts and presence even when life is hard.
- Practice: List 5 things you're grateful for and thank God aloud for them.

Day 11 — Theme: Sacrificial Love

- Scripture: John 15:12–13
- Prayer: Lord, teach me to love sacrificially as you loved me—help me lay down my preferences for others.
- Practice: Do something today that costs you time, comfort, or resources to bless another.

Day 12 — Theme: The Cross — Reflection

- Scripture: Luke 23:26–49
- Prayer: Jesus, I stand before your cross in awe—thank you for bearing my sin and shame.
- Practice: Read the crucifixion account slowly; imagine the scene and offer a prayer of gratitude.

Day 13 — Theme: Waiting and Hope

- Scripture: Romans 8:24–25
- Prayer: God of hope, teach me patience as I wait for your promises & for the joy of Easter.
- Practice: Spend intentional time in hopeful expectation—listen to a worship song, sing a worship song, or read an Easter promise passage.

Day 14 (Holy Saturday / Easter Vigil) — Theme: Resurrection Anticipation

- Scripture: Matthew 28:1–10
- Prayer: Risen Lord, prepare my heart to meet you with joy; help me live as one transformed by your resurrection.
- Practice: On Easter Saturday or Sunday, read the Resurrection account aloud, celebrate with prayer and praise, and participate in corporate worship with other believers that Jesus is RISEN!
