

5 Day Devotional: "Cracking the Code - Live to Leave a Legacy"

Day 1: Grace Provides the Means

Scripture Reading:* Titus 2:11-12

Scripture Reading: Titus 2:12

Scripture Reading: Titus 2:13

Day 4: Grace Provides the Message

Scripture Reading: Titus 2:14

Reflection: Christ gave Himself to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession who are zealous for good works. Reflect on the message of redemption and purity. How can you share this message with others?

Application: Christ's sacrifice redeems us and purifies us for good works. Consider how you can embody this message in your interactions with others. Perhaps through acts of kindness, sharing your testimony, or engaging in community service.

Prayer: Jesus, thank You for redeeming me. Help me to live a life that reflects Your purity and to share Your message with those around me. Make me zealous for good works that honor You.

Day 5: Living to Leave a Legacy

Scripture Reading: Titus 2:15

Reflection: Declare these things; exhort and rebuke with all authority. Let no one disregard you. Reflect on how you can declare the truths of grace and salvation in your life. Consider ways to mentor and guide others in their faith journey.

Application: Living to leave a legacy involves teaching and modeling the truths of grace and salvation. Consider how you can mentor others, share your faith story, and live in a way that others see Christ in you.

Prayer: Lord, empower me to declare Your truths with boldness. Help me to leave a legacy of faith that impacts future generations. Guide me in mentoring others and sharing Your love.
