Opening Prayer

Icebreaker

Discussion Questions:

1. God Is Faithful

Read: Genesis 1:26–27; Exodus 34:6

- What does it mean that we are created in God's image?
- How does God's faithfulness shape the way we live?
- Have you ever had to trust God's faithfulness in a difficult season?

2. Faithfulness Is Fruit

Read: Galatians 5:22–23

- Why is faithfulness called fruit of the Spirit?
- What distractions make it hard to stay faithful?
- Where do you need the Holy Spirit's help to remain steady?

3. Faithful with What We Have

Read: Matthew 25:14–23

- What stands out to you in the parable of the talents?
- What has God entrusted to you?
- Why is comparison dangerous to faithfulness?

4. Faithfulness Over Fear

Read: Matthew 25:24–26

- How did fear affect the third servant?
- How can fear keep us from obeying God?
- Is there anything God has given you that you have been hiding or avoiding?
