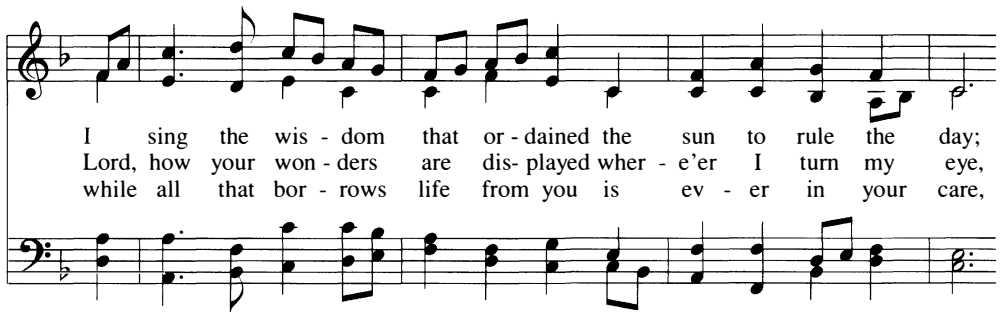
Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the LORD our Maker. Ps. 95:6



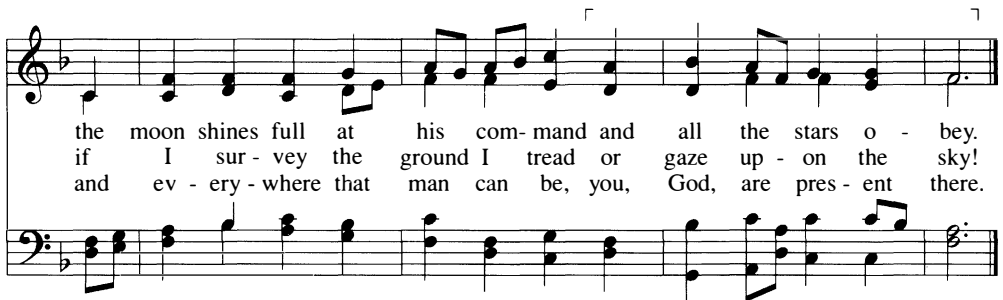

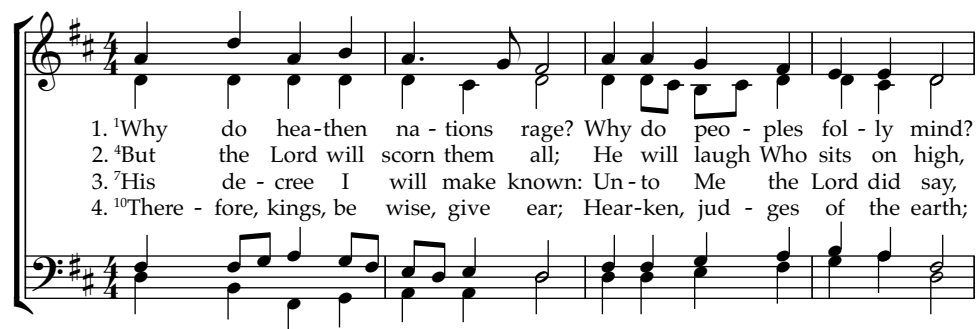

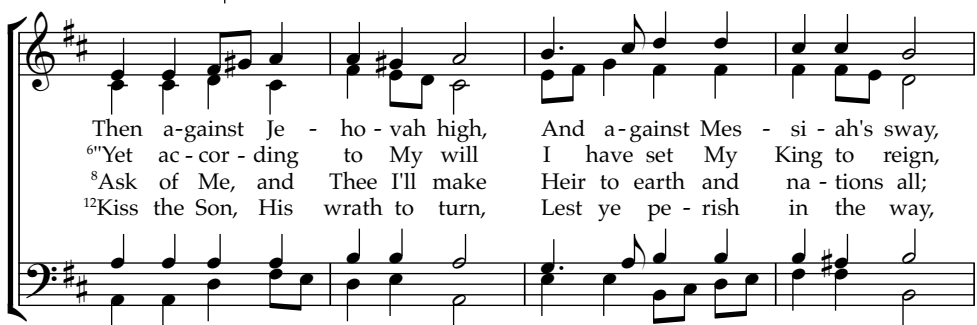
Psalm 2
