## GUYANA MISSION APRIL & MAY 2022

April and May were busy time for us. The contractors returned to work on the building and were able to cast the balcony on the 7<sup>th</sup> of April which was my birthday. Talking about a birthday gift that was it. The work went into the evening but we got it done which was so good. That gave us time to work towards the concert and the team that came on the 14<sup>th</sup> April. We were happy to have the curfew lifted for mass gathering in time for our Good Friday night concert. Everyone was excited about the concert as we sold 300 tickets at US\$150 per ticket and all the tickets were sold out setting the stage for a large crowd. Terry Williams Guyanese living in the USA came and used his instrument for free to help us raise funds for the building. We had our Good Friday morning service then set things up on the new building floor for the concert in the evening. People came in their numbers and we ran out of seats it was around 500 persons at the concert. “To God be the glory great things He had done.” Signs of what to expect when this building is complete. The concert was a huge success.

The Saturday we shared out few kites to children. It was little disappointed with the turn out with the children as we were hoping to have about 300 but just got around 100. We shared few more Sunday morning and then went to the beach and shared few there and some in Alness as we drove around children were excited to received their kite.

After we went and got Dr. Patti registered to practice here, she worked on Wednesday and Thursday and saw 70 persons. Those who saw her said they were very happy with the way she treated them and hope she will return and she is planning to return this October God's willing.

After Wayne King and the team returned it was time for us to return to work on the building to put up the walls and cast the ring beam which finished on the 9<sup>th</sup> June which was a big deal for us setting the stage for the roof which we want to start next month God's willing, there were eight men who went to help cast the ring beam which we are very thankful for the help as allowed us to saved cost and got the work finished early, this is a another good sign and the contractors are visiting us in fellowship. I am waiting on the contractors to know when they will start plastering.

We thank God for where we at and all those who are working for Him and our prayer partners and supporters.

We are trusting God to finish the building in September and plan for our Harvest/thanksgiving service in October and to have Wayne King and team to return in October to follow up with the medical outreach and having them to work in the new building which will give them more room to work with.

Wayne King will do some training with four of the men and myself into leadership.

Please continue to pray for us so God will provide the workers and funds to complete the building. We are open for mission teams to come help us finish the build soon as we are looking to have the dedication on our 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary as a church on the 5<sup>th</sup> February, 2023 plans are to have the president of our country to be there, so we need to finish early so we will see how to handy a crow and will be sending the invitation so he will know the building is complete because he will send his personnel to check the building before so we need to finish early. We are anticipating a in flock of persons after the anniversary.

We already having persons coming and accepting memberships with us and I know it will continue.
