Haiti Mission Trip: May 23-June 2, 2022

It has been one & one-half years (October 2020) since Chuck Perry & Donnie Campbell were last in Dufailly, Haiti.

The covid, the assassination of Haiti's President, rapid inflation, shortages, civil unrest-including kidnappings, killings – all have made travel to Haiti nearly impossible. Travel advisory's include Level 4 warnings NOT to travel to Haiti.


Yvrose was a victim of breaking in and stealing medicine and equipment out of the Clinic. That left no choice but to surround the compound with a tall concrete wall – including church, school & clinic.

Despite the evil of a few, our village is still filled with the same warm people we have grown to love.

Yvrose & Thomas still work long hours to oversee and provide classes for 250 plus kids in Dufailly school and 150+ kids in the new church/school in Degot.




While there we made the long walk up the mountain behind Dufailly to visit the school in Degot. We found teachers, students, black boards, desks and 6 classes for education to grade 7. We met with the headmaster who took us to each class where we met with the teachers and students. Students were attentive as we introduced ourselves and asked them to explain their lessons. Gutters and a 1000 gallon water tank provide water for the school.




All this because of the vision Yvrose continues to have for her village. God's faithfulness and the faithfulness of her supporters had made these and other improvements possible despite \$15 gas on the black market, higher food and lumber prices and a government made up of only a few elected officials. Uncertainty is not new to Haiti.

Each day begins with kids traveling on foot dressed in their uniforms and adults traveling to work or market. Yvrose's school has become as good as any school in the area. Plus we teach the Bible each week. Good grades along with Christian studies have provided our village with many good quality young people. We have a good number who have completed all grades here in Dufailly Christian Mission. Bible studies, choirs, music lessons make for a strong presence in Dufailly Christian Church on Sundays. Sunday School began at 7:30 and we left the church building at 11:45 a.m. The seats were filled with 130+ in attendance.









Many draw their strength from God. And a worship service in Dufailly Christian is not lacking in the study of the Apostles teaching, the breaking of bread, fellowship and prayer.

The World has disappointed Haiti many times throughout its history. But the Haitians have witnessed the faithfulness of God even in the darkest of times.

As we prepare to leave, we could spend much time on the challenges they face, but even with all the challenges we will leave encouraged not just hopeful, but sure that God will continue to be gracious to the Dufailly Christian Mission!

We came to encourage with prayer – support – using our hands and feet, but will leave once again blessed because we were able to spend some time with Yvrose, Thomas & family and all those involved with Dufailly Christian Mission!
