Adding to the Kingdom

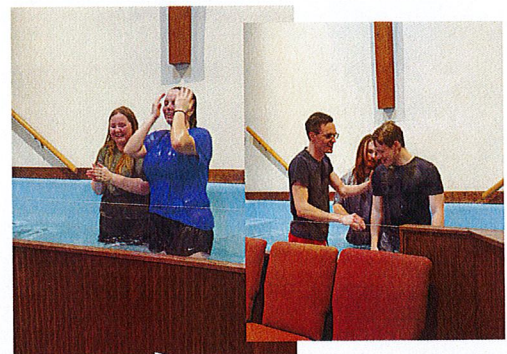

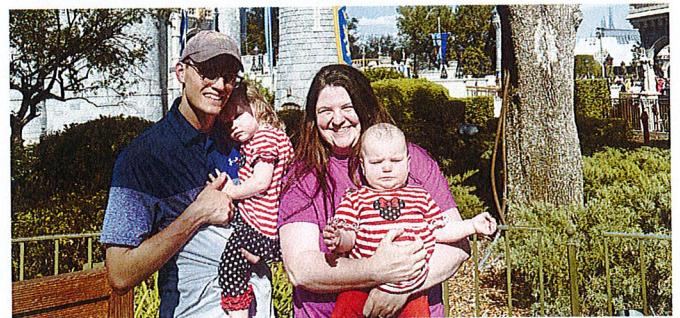
Reaching the Campus
