Greetings to all from Mission Journeys – Global Bible School (GBS). Mission Journeys is working in Appalachia in Kentucky and Belize in Central America. GBS is working in nine countries: Philippines, Kenya, Guyana, Zambia, Tanzania, Rwanda, Democratic Republic of the Congo Burundi and Pakistan.



Guyana, South America

Doctors Patti and Bill Poczatek, (doctors son) and I made a trip to Guyana April 7-15. We ran a three-day medical clinic at Alness Revival Christian Church. Doctors Patti and Bill saw 140 people in the clinic. Jack and I dispensed medication from the pharmacy. Each time we come, the community seems to deepen their trust of the clinic and the people serving in the clinic. We had two nights of training with the congregation on being faithful to God. The congregational training was well received with some of deep spiritual conversations. Bill preached his first message on April 12th.

Philippines

Ivan Spencer, Minister at Fox Creek Christian Church and I made a trip to the Philippines April 21 -May 13. We taught Church Leadership and Church Administration. The courses were well received. Ivan each day lead a training on remaining healthy as a Church leader. We had 15 students the first week and 16 students the second week. The Gabas Church of Christ (new church plant) continues to add small groups. Plans are to start a total of 10 small groups this year. The church is also ministering in the local prison. Recently they had four baptisms. Ivan preached at Gabas Church of Christ during our Philippines trip. As reported in March, the building at Sta. Rosa Church of Christ, the replacement for the Candelaria Church of Christ building, is finished. This is the replacement building that was lost in heavy rains and mud slides last fall. I preached at Sta. Rosa Church of Christ during the Philippines trip. We continue to support several prison ministry locations and several Church offering VBS programs this summer.

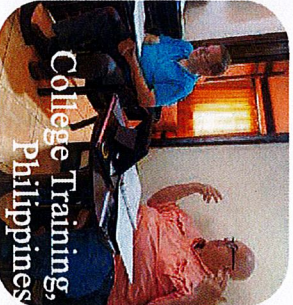
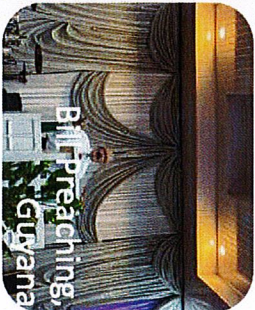
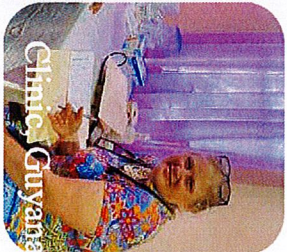
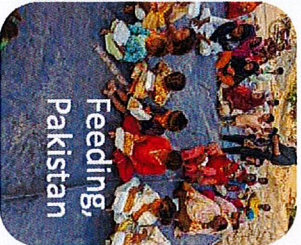
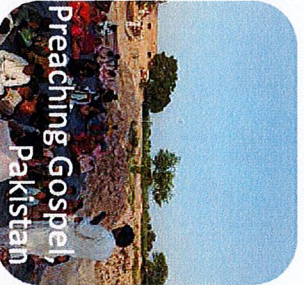
Africa – Tanzania, Kenya and Zambia

In Kibaha, we continue to help purchase materials to improve the church building used by the International Bible School.

In Dar es Salaam, we have helped with printing lesson materials and 220 Bibles for work in a secondary school. The work in the school has grown, with plans to add additional students in the fall semester. He has also started a street evangelism ministry to share the Gospel. In Kenya, we have helped by providing funds for Bibles and medical needs. Plans are for a return trip July 29 – September 9. This trip will include trips to India, Tanzania, Malawi and Burundi.
