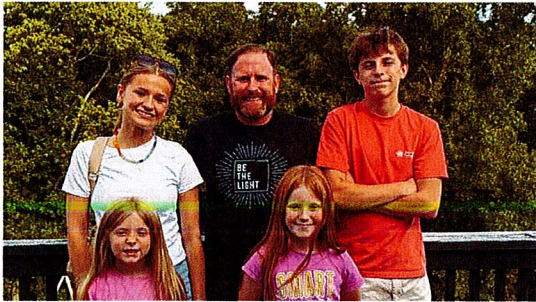
A Month of Seeing God Move

Happy belated Father's Day to all the amazing dads!

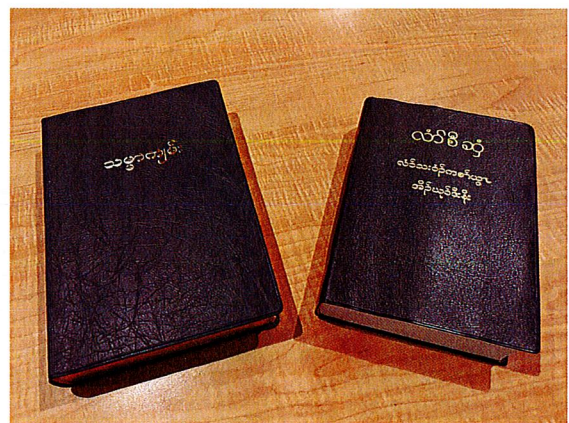

Sedrick

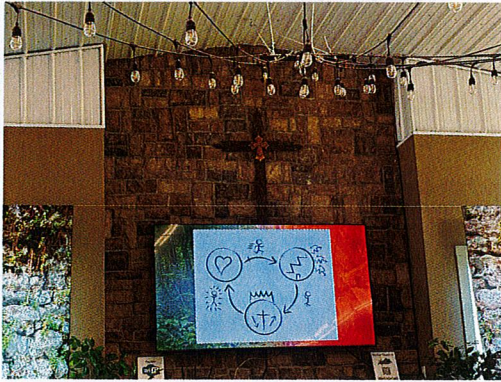
This month our family had the opportunity to attend the Juneteenth Celebration after being invited by our friend and brother in Christ, Sedrick.

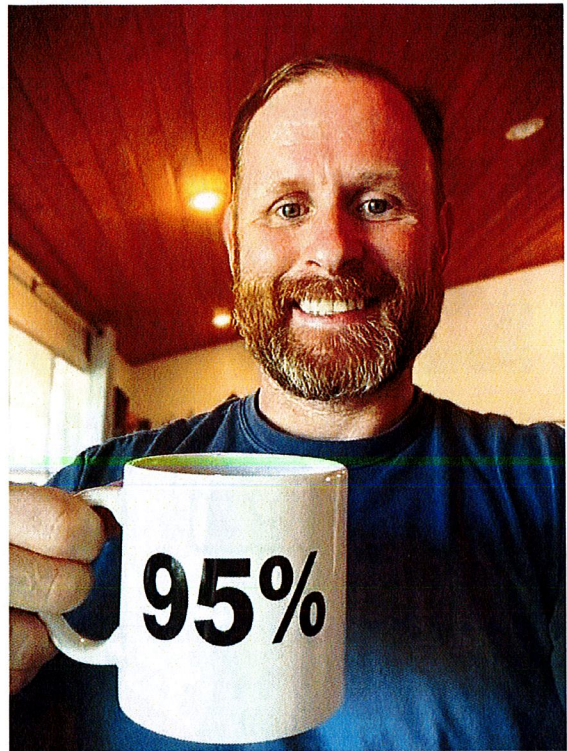
We are still hovering around 95% funded,

Nigerian striker Victor Osimhen's journey to the 2026 FIFA World Cup is a profound testimony to his deep faith. Growing up near a Lagos dumpsite, Victor lost his mother at thirteen. He hawked water in traffic, cleaned gutters for pennies, and often slept in empty church buildings. Yet, his relentless work ethic earned a national youth trial and, today, Osimhen is a superstar forward, famously wearing a mask after a severe facial injury. Humbly, he quietly funds support for the poor and disabled across Nigeria. His life reminds us that any obstacle can be overcome, and the highest honor is always to serve those in need.

Osimehn has said, "I try to be a role model and show God's graciousness and God's glory through my life." Team Expansion missionaries live for the same higher Cause. Thanks for empowering, encouraging, and praying them through each and every day.
