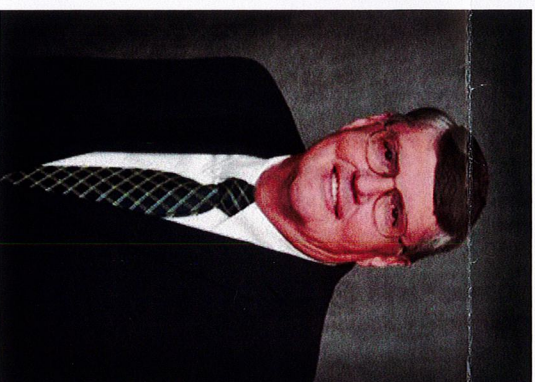

At the June 4, 2026 Board of Regents meeting, **Dr. Terry Peer**, Executive Vice President of Louisville Bible College **was approved as President – Elect**. God has blessed LBC so much in the past six years, and with the appointment of VP Peer, I am confident LBC will continue to thrive.

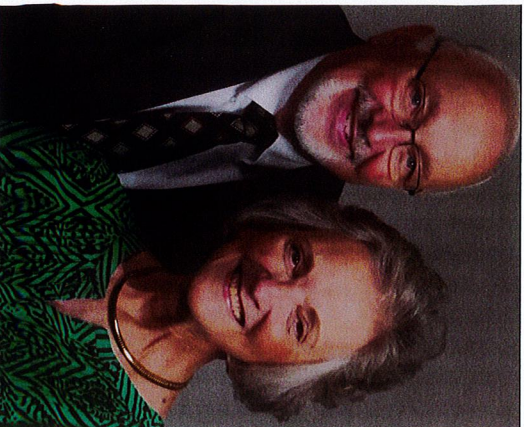
My confidence is based on the truth contained in the scripture heading for this article. It says everything that needs to be said about the upcoming change in administration. First, it says everything is for a season. Please allow me to share a few ways God has blessed my season of service at LBC:

- LBC became debt-free and now sits on a firm foundation for continued operation
- There is a dedicated faithfulness to the LBC Mission
- The faculty, staff, and administration have been expanded
- Enrollment has increased
- An online option for taking classes has been implemented
- The campus has been improved

But, it is a season. In the 2025–26 *Annual Reviews and Reflections* document I submitted to the Regents in June, I described LBC as having entered a, "New era." I am firmly convinced that a new leader needs to lead through this 'new era'.

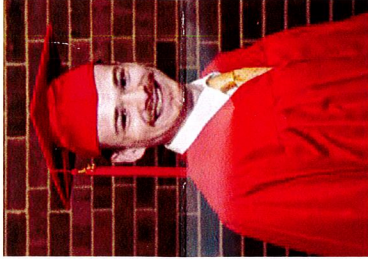

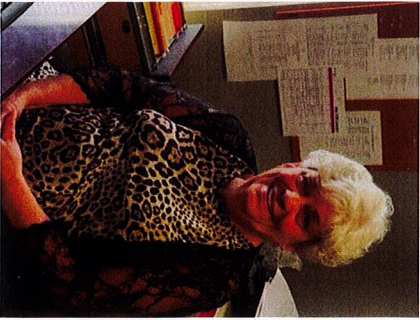

We're excited to welcome Donna Barnes as our new Office Assistant.

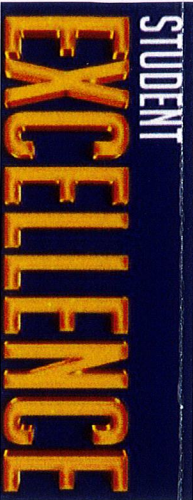
