We are excited about the conversations taking place and the possibilities ahead as we work together to see more churches engaged in the mission of making disciples.

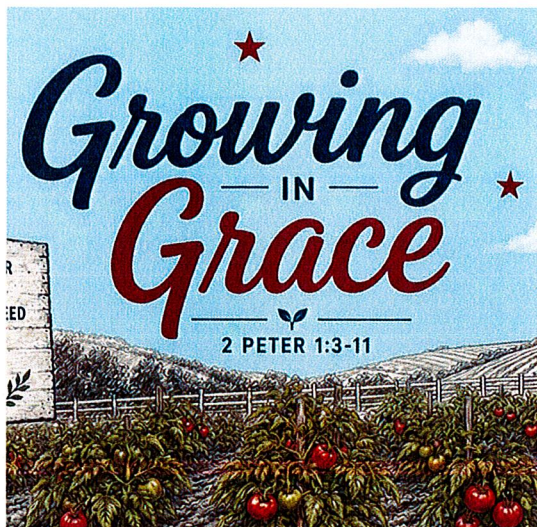


Reverence
