We hope and pray this letter finds you, your family and ministry doing well. Our family is doing well and God has been very good to us. Thank you for your continued support and prayers for us as family. For without your fervent prayers for us, the work here in Germany would be an impossible task to accomplish.

This year has been very difficult for our family and church. God is faithful and has led us every step of the way. Even in times of discouragement and pain he is faithful to comfort and strengthen us. Please be in prayer for both us and the amazing church God has led us to serve here in Bassenheim, Germany.

We started off the year with church-wide prayer and fasting. Every evening, we as a church met at different locations to pray and fast. Four of our faithful families opened their home in the same week with about twenty people in attendance every night. God used this week of prayer and fasting to encourage and strengthen us. We even had a few non-members attend that enjoyed the time of fellowship and prayer.

A few months ago, a woman named Olga Horst started attending our services. After getting to meet her, we found out that she had recently accepted Jesus Christ in her heart! A friend recommended she attend our services since she only lives 10 minutes away from the church. She has been regularly attending our services for the last four months. She recently unregistered from the Lutheran state church and would like to be baptized as soon as possible. We plan on baptizing her in May. Hopefully it will be a little warmer outside. Please pray for her husband Johann, he is lost. I have had some great conversations with him at his home and church. I would love to see him get saved so that I can baptize both in May.

A growing church is constantly in transition. We currently have lost four faithful families. It seems that the non-denominational, Pentecostal and Calvinistic churches are growing like wildfire here in Germany. Last year, we had a man join our church that I had been counseling. This year we have 3 faithful families (Hübert, Hiebert & Harms) that would like to join our church. The Harms family have surrendered to full-time ministry as missionaries and are currently attending bible college. It has been a blessing for Nicole and I to minister unto this young German couple as they prepare for the mission field. Thank you for praying for us, we send our love and greetings from Germany.
