

Mission Field: The Republic of Namibia, the Republic of Zambia and the Democratic Republic of the Congo

Mission Trip Dates: From July 1, 2026 through February 25, 2027(8 months)

Mission Trip General Agenda: Evangelism, church planting, Discipleship, Equipping church leaders (pastors, Evangelists, apostles and more) for an effective and sustainable ministry and Empowering in holistic way the needy vulnerable and forgotten children, women and disabled people with social, educational and medical assistance: Feeding the hungry, Farming God's Way (teaching people on how to get food security), Distribution of free mobility equipment (Ministry of mercy). It is our joy (Eleonore and I) to answer yes to heaven's call (mandate) of service to these African countries: *"I will rescue you from your own people and from the Gentiles, I am sending you to them to*



open their eyes and turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, so that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me” **Acts 26:17-18**. “The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, to proclaim the year of the Lord’s favor” **Luke 4:18-19**. “How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? 3. **Mission Trip activities:**
 - **Evangelism meeting with Gospel proclamation, healings, Deliverances prayers and New Church Planting**
 - **Church leaders’ equipping training**
 - **Reaching out and Empowering Himba people in holistic way with the Gospel and social assistance: (leading them to Christ, feeding the hungry and clothing them).**



ZAMBIA

1. **Zambia:** The Republic of Zambia is a landlocked country at the crossroads of Central, Southern and Eastern Africa. Capital; Lusaka. Population: 20.72 million (2023 World Bank with English as official language).
2. **Mission Trip Date:** From Monday July 13, 2026 to Wednesday July 21, 2026
3. **Mission Trip activities**
 - **Evangelism meeting with Gospel proclamation, healings, Deliverances prayers and New Church Planting**
 - **Church leaders’ equipping training**
 - **Reaching out and Empowering Himba people in holistic way with the Gospel and social assistance: (leading them to Christ, feeding the hungry and clothing them).**

The Trip back to the United States of America will be on Wednesday July 22, 2026 with a transition time of two weeks from Thursday July 23, 2026 to Sunday August 2, 2026. (Processing time for getting the visa for Congo Democratic Republic Mission Trip)



THE DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF THE CONGO

- 1. The Democratic Republic of the Congo:** The Democratic Republic of the Congo, also called by the DR Congo is a Country in Central Africa by land area. It is the second largest country in Africa and the 11th largest in the world. Capital: Kinshasa. Population: 112 million (wikipedia.com) with French as official language.
- 2. Mission Trip Dates:** From Monday August 3, 2026 through February 25, 2027 (7 months).
- 3. Mission Trip Agenda:** Evangelism, church planting, Discipleship, Equipping church leaders (pastors, Evangelists, apostles and more) for an effective and sustainable ministry and Empowering in holistic way the needy vulnerable and forgotten children, women and disabled people with social, educational and medical assistance: Feeding the hungry, Farming God's Way (teaching people on how to get food security), Distribution of free mobility equipment (Ministry of mercy).
- 4. Mission Trip Activities :**
 - A. Evangelism meeting , new church planting ,Discipleship and Leadership Training in these targeted 20 villages or areas:**
 - Singa Inga and Buma (Kinshasa)
 - Lufu (Territory of Songolo / Congo central province)
 - Kwenge Secteur (Territory of Bulungu/ kwilu province)
 - Kindamba, Gimweji, Ngungu Gatuta, Kangu, Mukoso, Lukajikaji, Mashini, Munzombo, Nvula and Lozo Munene village (Territory of Gungu/Kwilu province)
 - Mungayi and Gisanga (Territory of Idiofa/Kwilu province)
 - Shamusenge, Tobi and Kamonia (Territory of Kamonia/Kasai occidental province)
 - B. Revival meeting, Discipleship and Leadership Training in these 7 local churches (Follow up ministry):**
 - Bibwa (Kinshasa), Kwenge village (Territory of Bulungu), Nzemba, Kapalanga, Kinzamba, Mumbambi (Territory of Gungu/Kwilu province) and Mukitshi village (Territory of Tshikapa/Kasai occidental province).
 - C. Academic ministry at Conventional Holistic University of Congo (UCHC/Boma)Teaching a class about Trauma Management**
 - Leading a spiritual leadership retreat for the students and staff at the University about "Servant Leadership"
 - D. Presentation of Jesus Film project in Singa Inga, Buma and Lufu.**
 - E. Feeding, clothing and counseling in Bibwa the orphans, needy children and the families, victims of the traumatizing and bloody invasion of the group rebel Mobondo in the bateke region.**
 - F. Soccer tournament with 8 teams for the students and villagers of Sambakhonde, Lwende, Gondo and Gisanga.**
