Ephesians 5:15-17, *"Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, making the best use of the time, because the days are evil. Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is."*

REVIEW last week:

Summary

This past Sunday, Pastor John challenged us to reconsider one of the most precious and overlooked gifts we have been given: the time of our lives. Paul urges us to walk wisely and make the best use of our time because the days are evil, we are invited to picture our lives as an hourglass, with every grain of sand representing a moment that, once passed, can never be reclaimed. The central insight here is both sobering and liberating. Most of us operate under the quiet assumption that we have plenty of time, yet that assumption has no foundation in reality. We must understand the difference between worldly wisdom, which tells us to accumulate, achieve, and consume, and godly wisdom, which teaches us to invest our days in what will truly last. When we begin to see our lives through this lens, everything shifts.

Key Points

- There are two kinds of wisdom: the wisdom of the world and the wisdom of God, and Christians are called to walk in godly wisdom
- True Christianity is not adding Jesus to one's life like gravy on a steak, but finding the totality of life in Christ Jesus
- Time is the most valuable commodity because no one can produce more of it, and it once passed can never be regained
- God makes His appeal to the world through His people, and believers have been entrusted with the message of reconciliation

Key Passages of Scripture:

- Colossians 3:1-4, which instructs believers raised with Christ to seek and set their minds on things above, where Christ is seated
- Romans 12:1-2, which calls believers to present themselves as living sacrifices and to be transformed by the renewing of their minds rather than being conformed to the world
- 1 John 2:15-17, which warns against loving the world or the things of the world, noting that the world and its desires are passing away
- Philippians 3:20, declaring that the citizenship of believers is in heaven, from which they await the return of Christ
- Romans 14:8, affirming that whether believers live or die, they belong to the Lord
