REVIEW last week:

Summary

Last Sunday's message revealed that fasting has never been about religious routine but about desperate, humble dependence on God. From Ezra leading a vulnerable group of people carrying enormous wealth through dangerous territory, to Nehemiah weeping for days over the broken state of Jerusalem, we see a pattern emerge: when God's people humble themselves, confess their sin, and cry out with genuine hearts, God moves. He grants favor with kings, protection on treacherous roads, and breakthrough in the face of impossible odds. The harvest around us is plentiful, and we are called to be the laborers. But kingdom work cannot be done in our own strength.

Key Points

- Fasting is nearly always paired with prayer in Scripture, and together they represent an act of deep humility and surrender before God.
- God responds to humble, sincere, repentant prayer, as demonstrated repeatedly throughout both the Old and New Testaments.
- When believers begin advancing the kingdom of God, they will encounter spiritual opposition, which is normal and expected in kingdom warfare
- There is an active, hierarchical spiritual war taking place in the unseen realm that directly manifests in the physical world, including in world empires, political events, and cultural decay
- The church is called to be warriors, not consumers, and must use the Word of God and prayer as its primary weapons

Key Passages of Scripture:

- Matthew 9:35-38, where Jesus describes the plentiful harvest and calls for laborers to be sent out
- Romans 15:4, which affirms that all Scripture was written for our instruction and to give us hope through endurance
- Nehemiah 1:4-6 and 1:11, depicting Nehemiah's personal fast, confession of sin, and prayer for divine favor before the king
- Isaiah 58:3-7, contrasting the fasting God rejects with the fasting He desires
