2 Corinthians 5:17-21, "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation; that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God."

A Sermon By Pastor John Riggs

REVIEW last week:

Summary

Last Sunday, Pastor John explored the profound biblical doctrine of reconciliation and what it truly means to be made right with God through Jesus Christ. He demonstrated that unlike every other world religion, where mankind attempts to climb toward God through works and religious activity, Christianity is uniquely the story of God descending to man. Through the sacrificial atonement of Christ, God has done everything necessary to reconcile sinful humanity to Himself. Central to this message is the doctrine of regeneration- the miraculous new birth by the Holy Spirit that transforms a believer into a new creation. This transformation includes the cleansing of sin, the gift of a new heart, the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, a new identity, a new purpose, and a new eternal destiny. Every born-again believer is commissioned as a minister of reconciliation, entrusted with the only message that can bring lost humanity into right relationship with God.

Key Points

- Reconciliation is entirely the work of God through Christ, not the result of human religious effort or works. God came down to man rather than man climbing toward God.
- The Greek word for "creation" in 2 Corinthians 5:17 refers to an act of creation, something only God can perform, paralleling the original creation account in Genesis.
- The urgency of sharing the gospel is heightened by the lateness of the hour, the hardening of hearts in culture, and the reality that there are no second chances after death.

Key Passages of Scripture:

- 2 Corinthians 5:14-21 (primary text -- the love of Christ, the new creation, and the ministry of reconciliation)
- Titus 3:4-7 (saved not by works but by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit)
- Ezekiel 36:25-27 (God's promise to cleanse, give a new heart, and place His Spirit within His people)
- 1 Corinthians 3:16 and 6:19-20 (the believer's body as the temple of the Holy Spirit)
- Galatians 2:20 (crucified with Christ; no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me)
