Summary

What does it mean to carry the most important message in human history? That is exactly what Pastor John challenged us to wrestle with as we explored 2 Corinthians 5:14-21, a passage that re-frames the entire purpose of our lives as followers of Christ. At the heart of this message is the doctrine of reconciliation, the idea that God, through Christ, has bridged the impossible gap between sinful humanity and a holy God. No religion, no philosophy, no human achievement could accomplish what Christ accomplished on the cross. And now, that same reconciling work has been entrusted to us. We are not passive recipients of grace. We are active ambassadors of the King of Kings, charged with delivering a message that carries eternal weight.

Key Points

- Every born-again believer holds the ministry of reconciliation, not just ordained ministers or clergy
- Reconciliation means being decisively changed from a position of enmity with God to a position of sonship and adoption through faith in Christ
- God took the initiative to reconcile humanity to Himself because no person can climb to a holy God through religious effort or moral achievement
- Two things compel faithful stewardship of this ministry: reverent fear of the Lord knowing all will give account, and the constraining agape love of Christ

Key Passages of Scripture:

- Romans 10:9-15, which traces the chain from confession and belief to salvation and asks how people will hear without someone proclaiming the message
- Ephesians 5:15-17, which calls believers to walk wisely and make the best use of their time because the days are evil
- Psalm 90:12, which asks God to teach people to number their days so they may gain a heart of wisdom
- John 15:13, which declares that greater love has no one than to lay down one's life for another
- 1 John 3:16, which connects knowing the love of God to the obligation of laying down one's life for others
