2 Corinthians 5:17-21, *"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation; that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God."*

A Sermon By Pastor John Riggs

REVIEW last week:

Summary

Last week, Pastor John called believers to a sober and urgent reckoning with the brevity of life and the weight of their commissioning. He challenged Christians to move beyond a world-conformed mindset and embrace the truth that Christ is not merely a part of life but is life itself. Because time cannot be reclaimed, every relationship, every vocation, and every moment carries kingdom significance. He emphasized that every born-again believer has been entrusted with the ministry of reconciliation, making the intentional use of time not merely a personal discipline but a spiritual responsibility. He warned that increasing wickedness in the last days will tempt believers toward spiritual exhaustion and emotional indifference, and called the church to guard their hearts, renew their minds through Scripture, and live with deliberate, Christ-centered purpose in all spheres of life.

Key Points

- The word "carefully" in Ephesians 5:15 carries the Greek meaning of exactness and diligence, calling believers to a precise and intentional way of living rooted in the Word of God
- Christ is not a compartment of the believer's life but is the believer's life, which transforms every ordinary activity into an act of worship and ministry
- Jesus warned in Matthew 24 that lawlessness would cause the love of many to grow cold, making the guarding of the heart a critical spiritual discipline in the last days

Key Passages of Scripture:

- Ephesians 5:15-17 — walking carefully, not as unwise but as wise, making the best use of time
- Psalm 90:12 — teaching us to number our days to gain a heart of wisdom
- Matthew 24 — signs of the end of the age, love of many growing cold
- Colossians 3:23 — doing all things heartily as unto the Lord
- 2 Corinthians 5:21 — He who knew no sin became sin so we might become the righteousness of God
- Matthew 9:37-38 — the harvest is plentiful but the workers are few, pray to the Lord of the harvest
