

Youth Ride Tuesday nights from 6:00 pm - 8:00 pm. Horseback riding lessons for all ages.


Every Tuesday Morning at 11:00 am

Ruck/Walk 30 min out 30 min back taking in God's creation and glory. Keeping his temple he blessed us with spiritually and physically fit.




Thirteen lessons blend Biblical truths with personal obedience and service.

We encourage believers to join this group to grow in their understanding of Biblical truths.






