What a spring season we've had so far! Rain is one of Scripture's most vivid reminders of God's presence in everyday life. In the ancient world, rain was not just a convenience; it was survival. Crops depended on it, families relied on it, and without it, the land withered. Because of this, God used rain as a powerful picture to reveal His character and attributes (Romans 1:20).

At its simplest, rain represents God's provision. In passages like Leviticus 26:4 and Deuteronomy 11:14, God promises to send rain "in its season" when His people walk with Him. Rain meant food, growth, and abundance. It was evidence that God was caring for His people. Even today, every blessing we receive reflects that same truth: God is the source of all that sustains us.

Yet Scripture also shows another side. When rain is withheld, it often signals something deeper. In 1 Kings 8:35-36, drought becomes a call to repentance. The absence of rain reminds people of their dependence on God and exposes how easily hearts can drift. Sometimes, what feels like a lack is actually an invitation to return.

Rain also reveals God's kindness to all people. Jesus said that the Father "sends rain on the just and the unjust" (Matthew 5:45). This means that even those who do not acknowledge Him still experience His goodness. Every rainfall becomes a quiet testimony of God's mercy, sustaining life across the earth.

But beyond physical provision, rain points to spiritual renewal. The prophets spoke of "early and latter rains" (Joel 2:23) as signs of restoration. Hosea calls us to seek the Lord "until He rains righteousness upon you" (Hosea 10:12). Just as dry ground needs water, our hearts need God's presence to bring life, growth, and healing. Rain, then, is more than weather. It is a picture of a God who provides, corrects, sustains, and restores. Every drop reminds us that life itself is a gift we cannot produce on our own.

So when you see rain, whether it falls gently or in a storm, let it turn your heart upward. Thank God for His provision. Ask if He is drawing you closer. And most of all, seek the spiritual rain only He can give, trusting that in His perfect timing, He will refresh your soul.

Youth Ride Tuesday nights from 6:00 pm - 8:00 pm. Horseback riding lessons for all ages.

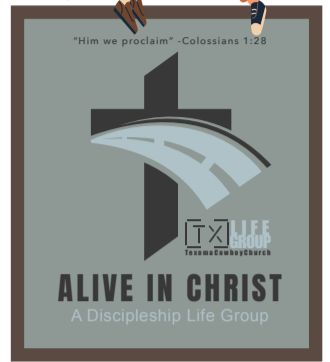
Adult rides 6:00 - 8:00 pm on the first Tuesday of the month.

Thirteen lessons blend Biblical truths with personal obedience and service. We encourage believers to join this group to grow in their understanding of Biblical truths.

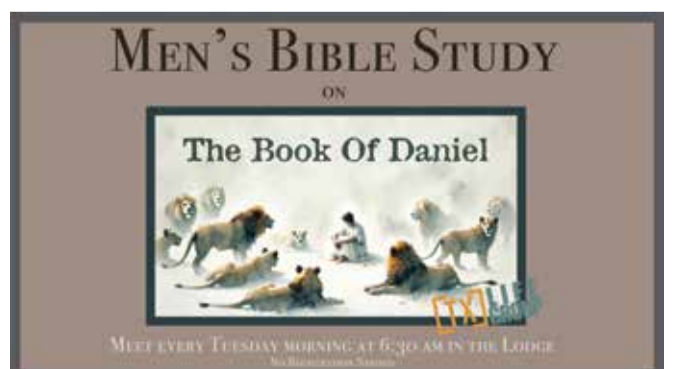

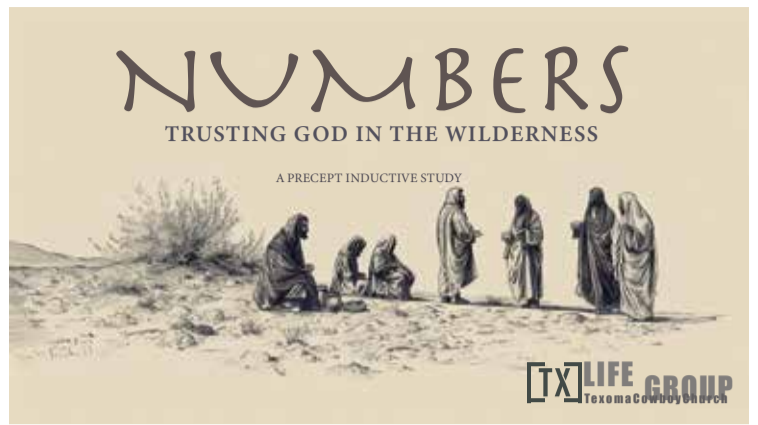

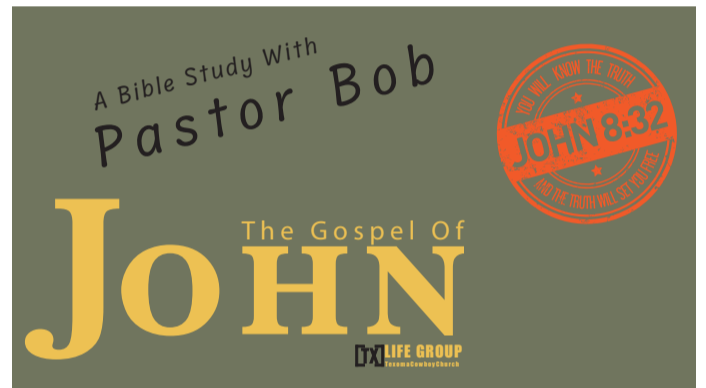
