

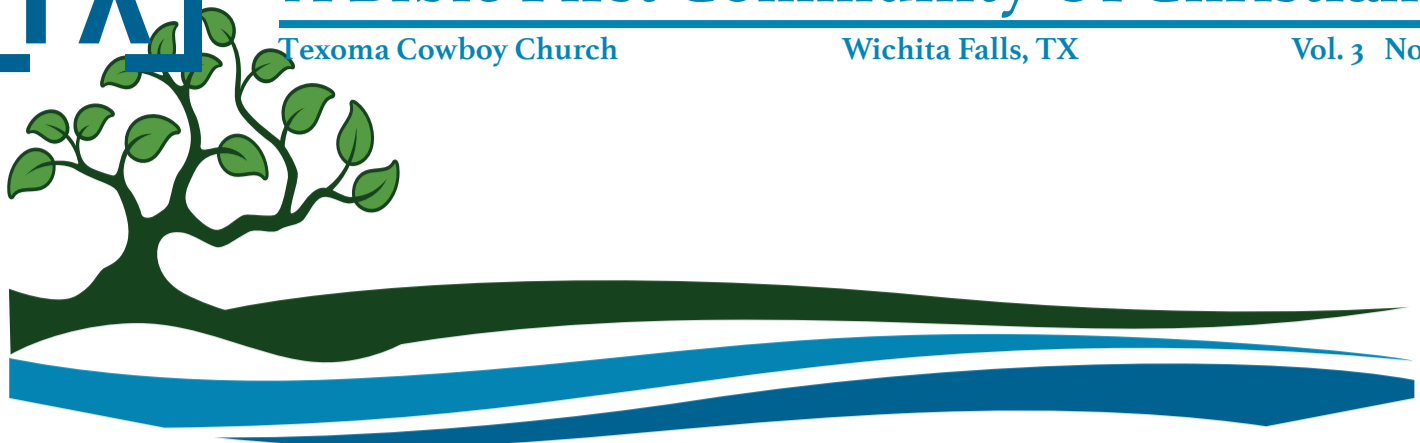


# A Bible First Community Of Christians!

*Blessed is the man that trusteth in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is. For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and that spreadeth out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat cometh, but her leaf shall be green; and shall not be careful in the year of drought, neither shall cease from yielding fruit. –Jeremiah 17:7-8*

Jeremiah paints a beautiful picture of the life of a tree planted by water, steady, nourished, and fruitful even in hard seasons. Our life in the Lord should look much the same, and it will if our spiritual roots drive beyond the shallow soils of emotional comfort and become embedded in the stability of God.

The prophet gives a true contrast concerning two ways to live life. Verses five through six exhibit a person relying on their own strength, understanding, and constantly seeking self-reliance with no prosperity. Then there is the blessed man, who rests in the Lord and finds life that can endure heat and drought. The tree does not avoid heat, nor does the believer avoid trials. The tree survives because its roots are reaching toward a "fountain of living waters", and the believer endures because their faith is anchored in the living water of God speaking through His word.

For the Christian, this trust is fulfilled in Christ. He is not only the One in whom we find salvation, but He is the One in whom God's promises and commands become sure. To trust Christ is not to drift into vague spirituality. It is to believe what God has spoken, to submit to His truth, and to let Scripture shape our thoughts, desires, and choices. Because our hearts naturally drift to the things of this world, we must keep ourselves near the steady stream of God's word. Only then will our hearts flow forth rivers of living waters. When we build our lives on Christ and on God's written word, we are not constantly struggling to escape quicksand, but instead we rest on the firm foundation of the Rock.

A life devoted to Jesus is not merely a religious exercise. It is growth. It is life itself. Each time we open the Bible, we are not simply searching for more knowledge. We are drinking from the stream that God provides. The word of God teaches us who Jesus is, what He has done, and how to stand firm and yield fruit when the heat comes. As Scripture renews our minds, the easier it becomes to submit our will to God and move from self-reliance to trust in Him. Ask yourself, where am I rooted? In the shallow, rocky soil of emotional comfort and self-help, or am I drawing life from Christ Jesus? God's promise which Jeremiah makes evident, is simple. A person who trusts in God will not be untouched by trials and hardship, but will endure those trials and hardships, and bear fruit because it is God who sustains him. In Christ, that life is not only possible, but blessed.

This is one of our kid's favorite Horses, Apache. He's one of the first horses to be a part of our ministry. He's gentle, loving, and will do just about anything we need him to!

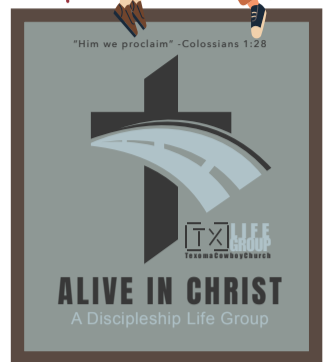

This is a discipleship life group. We are taking a break for the summer! Look for info this fall.



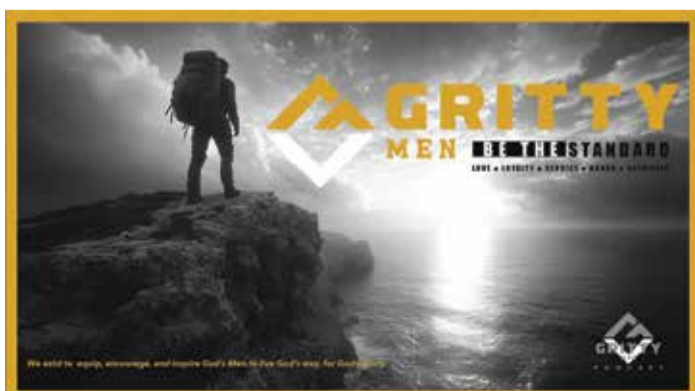
Ruck/Walk 30 min out 30 min back taking in God's creation and glory. Keeping his temple he blessed us with spiritually and physically fit.



Currently on break for the SUMMER! Look for information in the fall.

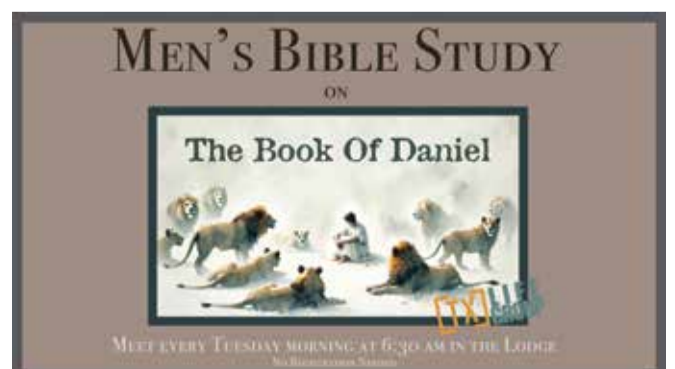

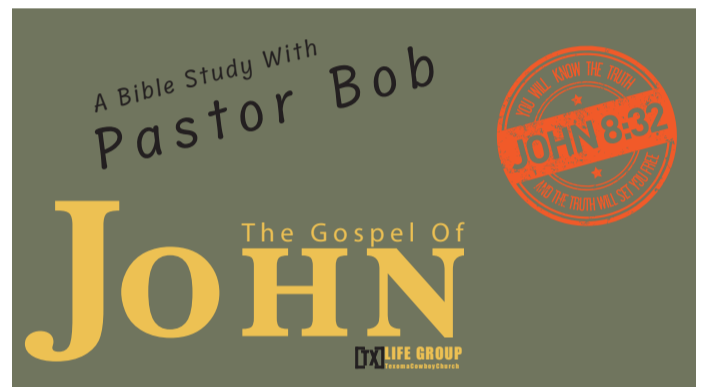
Scripture guides you toward God. An inductive study guides you through Scripture. Discover the truth of Scripture for yourself, but not by yourself.
