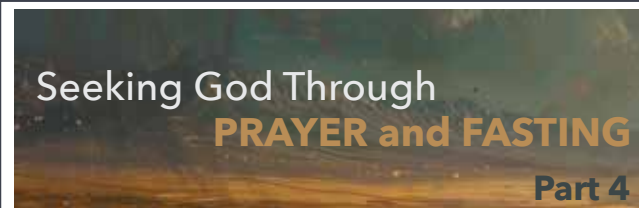

A Sermon By Pastor John Riggs

REVIEW last week:

Summary

Last week, Elder Terry McCurrin drew from James chapter 4 and wove together with a broader call to prayer and fasting, this sermon challenges Christians to examine whether their hearts are truly and wholly devoted to God or divided between faith and the ways of the world.

The central call is for believers to pursue a pure, whole, and undivided heart toward God, recognizing that genuine faith, sustained fellowship with Christ, and humble submission are the foundations for answered prayer and spiritual victory.

Key Points

- Genuine saving faith produces works of obedience; salvation comes by faith alone, but authentic faith will naturally result in doing the works God has prepared for each believer.
- Double-mindedness, claiming faith in God while clinging to worldly ways, produces spiritual instability and prevents believers from receiving from God.
- Prayer and fasting serve to remove distractions, align the heart with God's will, and position believers for God to move powerfully on their behalf.
- Pride and arrogant self-reliance are spiritually dangerous; believers must acknowledge God's authority over their plans and futures
- The ultimate accountability belongs to Christ, before whom every person will one day stand and hear either commendation or rejection

Key Passages of Scripture:

- James 4 serves as the primary text, addressing worldliness, double-mindedness, pride, and the call to submit to God and draw near to Him
- Psalm 51, verses 1 through 10, in which David cries out to God for a clean heart and renewed spirit following his sin
- Matthew 12, verses 36 through 37, on accountability for careless words
- 1 Chronicles 28, verse 9, David's charge to Solomon to serve God with wholehearted devotion
