SEAN – Questions and Answers

What makes SEAN different from any other study I've been involved in?

Through SEAN's unique method of teaching you'll be able to retain what you learn, develop spiritual disciplines, see changes in your life and impact the lives of others as you allow the Holy Spirit to teach and guide you.

What is SEAN?

SEAN stands for Study by Extension to All Nations. Originally it was designed by missionaries to train pastors and church leaders who couldn't take time out to go to Bible College. SEAN will help you grow in your relationship with God and God will use it to equip you to touch the lives of those around you. Some of our students are taking it to help prepare for fulltime ministry.*

What do you learn in SEAN?

Everything!..... Or so it may seem. The focus of the course is on the life and ministry of Jesus Christ as recorded in the book of Matthew. As you go through the course you'll also learn about:

- False Cults
- Bible study techniques
- Missions
- Family Life
- Bible Geography
- The book of Acts
- Christian Ethics
- How the church functions
- Inter-personal dynamics
and much more.

In fact you'll touch on over 200 topics!

How does SEAN work?

In SEAN you'll;

- Study at home using a book that becomes your teacher
- Meet once a week with a tutor in a small group setting
(each class is a maximum of 2 hours)
- Take a weekly quiz (which we refer to as a quizito) and a final exam at the end of each volume. Each volume takes about 3 months to complete and there are a total of 6 volumes.

The Schedule follows a typical School Year schedule:
summers and holidays off -- so if you have children in school or are in school yourself, the teaching schedule is practical!

Wow! Is it hard?

No! Answers are provided at the bottom of each page in your book and you'll be surprised by how much you'll learn so quickly! Each module builds on the module before so everything makes logical sense, making it easier to learn.

SEAN really isn't for someone like me is it?

Actually anyone can take SEAN. Past students have included; Homemakers, high school drop outs, pastors, elders, young adults, retired people, businessmen and those preparing for ministry.

Is there a cost?

Yes but the cost is minimal especially when you compare it to regular College Courses. Believe it or not the cost is no more than \$45 a semester Includes book and registration.
