Joshua 21:43-45, 24:1-2, 11-15

A The Old Testament Reading is from Joshua, chapters 21 and 24.

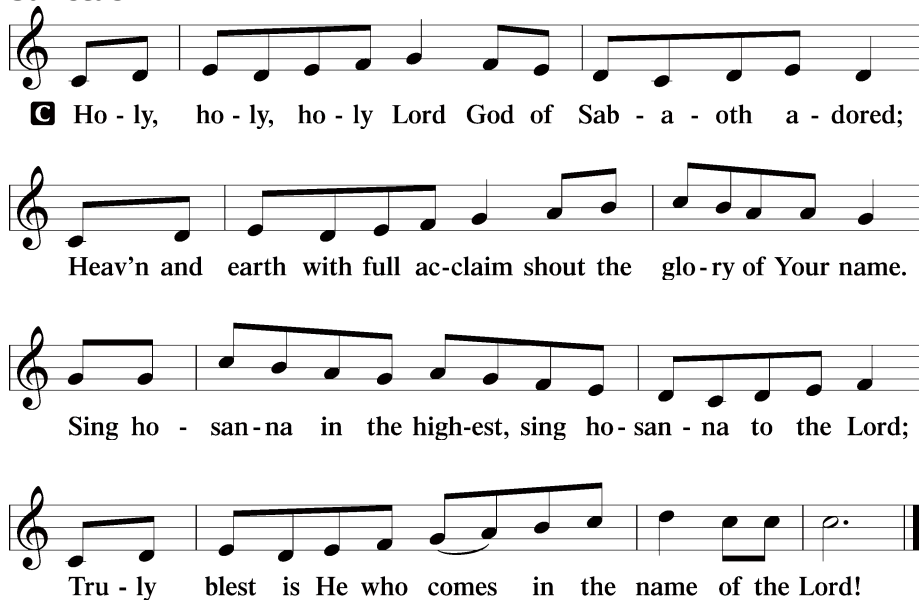

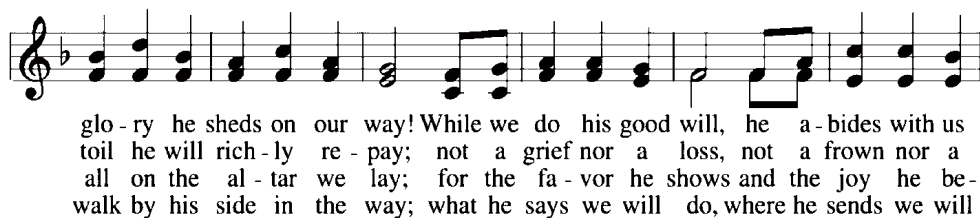
