**Questions:**

➤ **Comprehension:**

What does the passage say in your own words?

*Questions or things you don't understand? Now is the time to ask!*

➤ **Interpretation:** What is the purpose of the passage for them and for us?

➤ **Interpretation:** Why did the islanders assume Paul was a murderer? How did their thinking change when he wasn't afflicted by the bite? Why is this important?

➤ **Interpretation:** What did unusual kindness and hospitality look like then? What does it look like today? How would lack of hospitality have changed the story here?

➤ **Application:** King Jesus has stripped the enemy of his power. Accusation, guilt, shame and fear no longer have power over us. How does this change the way you think?

➤ **Application:** We have an opportunity to bring peace in the midst of chaos, care in the midst of suffering, and hope for the hopeless. Who in your life needs you to share this with them? What does this look like practically in your life?
