**MAIN POINT: What is a proper view of the kingdom and why is it important?**

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## Questions:

### ➤ **Comprehension:**

What does the passage say in your own words?

*Questions or things you don't understand? Now is the time to ask!*

➤ **Interpretation:** What is the purpose of the passage for them and for us?

➤ **Interpretation:** The passage notes a divided response: “some were convinced... others did not believe” (v. 24). Why do you think people, then and now, have such polarized reactions to the gospel?

➤ **Interpretation:** How does this concluding chapter show the “unstoppable nature” of the Gospel, despite Paul being in chains?

➤ **Application:** In what ways are you tempted to stop sharing the gospel with certain people, and how does Acts 28:28 challenge that temptation?

➤ **Application:** How does this concluding chapter show the “unstoppable nature” of the Gospel, despite Paul being in chains?

➤ **Application:** ‘The Kingdom of God is God’s presence with God’s people in God’s place for God’s purpose.’ How does this impact you? How does it change the way you see the Kingdom? How does it change how you think about your place in the kingdom?
