

SPEAKER: ALLAN WILTSHIRE

Allan is a follower of Jesus, devoted husband to his wife, Christa, and father to their two daughters. He is a former U.S. Marine turned Wealth Management Advisor who leverages his leadership experience in military operations to inform his disciplined approach to helping clients pursue secure, purpose-filled financial futures.

Allan commissioned as a second lieutenant and graduated from The Citadel with a bachelor's degree in history. Allan began his Marine Corps career in the infantry, where he served as a platoon commander and company executive officer. He led counter-insurgency efforts in Helmand Province, Afghanistan, disrupting Taliban influence in the region.

Allan also led security and intelligence activities in Sana'a, Yemen during the Iranian-backed Houthi uprising. After being selected for Marine Special Operations Command (MARSOC), he led elite teams of Marine Raiders to carry out sensitive missions across the middle east and was awarded the Bronze Star for his actions.

After nearly a decade of military service, Allan transitioned to the civilian sector. He earned an MBA from the University of Georgia's Terry College of Business, where he was a Terry Excellence Fund scholar and served as a graduate assistant and veteran liaison.
