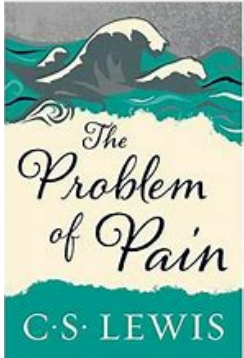
# MEETING
