

YEAR 1 INTERNSHIP REQUIREMENTS

In Class Requirements

1. Lead Classroom Prayer Liturgy

Satisfies competencies 2, 9, and 15 of the Beginning Ministerial Internship

Prayer liturgies are found at nr.church/nrsm by scrolling down to the “**Student Resources**” section and clicking on the “YEAR ONE” tab. You will be scheduled for this opportunity.

2. Enroll, participate, and pass Relationships & Ethics

Satisfies competencies 3, 4, 6, and 7 of the Beginning Ministerial Internship

Your regular attendance in class is required for this internship competency - in brief list competencies to expect.

3. Participate in all APEST Workshops/Labs

Satisfies competencies 18, 32, and 33 of the Beginning Ministerial Internship

Classroom discussions will support exploration of personal kingdom purpose. Students will be responsible to pay a \$10 fee to take the 5Q assessment required for these activities. The assessment can be found by going to the “**Student Resources**” section and clicking on the “YEAR ONE” tab.

4. Complete and submit required APEST assignments

Satisfies competencies 5, 8, 12, 16, 17, 26, and 28 of the Beginning Ministerial Internship

Assignments are found through nr.church/nrsm by scrolling down to the “**Student Resources**” section and clicking on the “YEAR ONE” tab. Assignments must be completed before class.

5. Attend all NRSM Chapel services

Satisfies competencies 10, 11, 20, 23, and 25 of the Beginning Ministerial Internship

On exam nights, prior to exams all students will attend a chapel led by an NRSM instructor or guest voice on a variety of topics to encourage, enrich, empower, and equip.

Out of Class Requirements

6. Serve regularly on a ministry team

Satisfies competencies 1, 19, 21, 24, and 31 of the Beginning Ministerial Internship

Students are required to serve a minimum of twice per month AND attend required ministry meetings. Go to nr.church/serve to discover opportunities to serve and be sure to fill out the “**serving interest form**” at the bottom to begin the process of joining a team.

7. Discuss volunteer development with your ministry team leader

Satisfies competencies 20, 21, 22, and 23 of the Beginning Ministerial Internship

Your ministry team leader will be determined by the team you serve on **OR** by the North Ridge School of Ministry instructors.

8. Arrange a fall semester 1:1 Pastoral Check-in with an NRSM Instructor

Satisfies competencies 30, 35, 36, 37, 38, and 39 of the Beginning Ministerial Internship

Students are to schedule a 1:1 meeting with their instructor of choice by the end of September, to be held and completed within October or November of their fall semester.

9. Complete required Old & New Testament reading assignments

Satisfies competency 34 of the Beginning Ministerial Internship

In the fall semester you will be tasked to read through the New Testament. In the spring semester you will be tasked to read through the Old Testament. This competency will be evaluated at your end of year exit interview. Reading plans are available on the Student Resource page linked at nr.church/nrsm.

10. Attend a Celebration Sunday OR equivalent baptism & child dedication service

Satisfies competencies 13 and 14 of the Beginning Ministerial Internship

For internal students, go to nr.church/info to consult upcoming events or scroll to the bottom and click the “**LEARN MORE**” bottom to see the full church calendar. For external students speak with a leader in your local ministry to determine calendar dates.

11. Attend a nonreligious event hosted by your city or organization in your city.

Satisfies competency 26 and 29 of the Beginning Ministerial Internship

Research opportunities in your community through your local municipalities.

12. Attend an Assemblies of God network event

Satisfies competency 27 of the Beginning Ministerial Internship

Many opportunities are available for this requirement and require travel. Consider pooling travel with other students. More details are available at WNMDAG.org/events. If event details are missing, call the Wisconsin Northern Michigan Network Office at (715) 258-8118.
