

YEAR 2 INTERNSHIP REQUIREMENTS

In Class Requirements

1. Lead an Adapted Classroom Prayer Liturgy

Satisfies competencies 2, 9, and 15 of the Intermediate Ministerial Internship

Prayer liturgies are found at nr.church/nrsm by scrolling down to the “**Student Resources**” section and clicking on the “YEAR TWO” tab. You will be scheduled for this opportunity.

Note: *Adapted means you will be expected to write an assigned liturgy in the modes provided using your own words and style. Music is not required. Instrumental tracks for background are allowed, lyrical music tracks are not permitted. (Optional: You can submit your adaptations and notes, & questions to an instructor for review at least one week prior to being scheduled.)*

2. Enroll, participate, and pass Conflict Management

Satisfies competencies 20, 21, and 24 of the Intermediate Ministerial Internship

Your regular attendance in class is required for this internship competency.

3. Complete & Submit required Homeletic Activity

Satisfies competencies 8, 16, and 17 of the Intermediate Ministerial Internship

Assignments are found through nr.church/nrsm by scrolling down to the “**student portal**” and clicking on the student resources tab. Assignments must be completed before class.

4. Complete and submit required Spiritual Gifts assignments

Satisfies competencies 18, 32, and 33 of the Intermediate Ministerial Internship

Assignments are found through nr.church/nrsm by scrolling down to the “**student portal**” and clicking on the student resources tab. Assignments must be completed before class.

5. Attend all NRSM Chapel services

Satisfies competencies 10, 11, 20, 23 and 25 of the Intermediate Ministerial Internship

On exam nights, prior to exams all students will attend a chapel led by an NRSM instructor or guest voice on a variety of topics to encourage, enrich, empower, and equip.

Out of Class Requirements

6. Serve regularly on a ministry team

Satisfies competencies 1, 19, 22, 24, and 31 of the Intermediate Ministerial Internship

Students are required to serve a minimum of twice per month AND attend required ministry meetings. Year 2 students are expected to work with your ministry leader to contribute content or organization to one or more regular meetings.

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7. Participate on a team or in an event that allows you to minister to people unfamiliar to the gospel

Satisfies competency 12 of the Intermediate Ministerial Internship

Several options are available to complete this competency. If an opportunity is not listed, please consult your instructor for approval. If one of the events below requires time away from the classroom, please provide that date to your relevant instructor so that an excused absence may be provided.

8. Arrange a spring semester 1:1 Pastoral Check-in with an instructor

Satisfies competency 30, 35, 36, 37, 38, and 39 of the Intermediate Ministerial Internship

See your student handbook for the contact information of instructors that can make themselves available to you. The student handbook can be found through nr.church/nrsm by scrolling down to the “**student portal**” and clicking on the student resources tab.

9. Complete all scripture reading assignments and keep a prayer journal in the academic year

Satisfies competency 34 of the Intermediate Ministerial Internship

The following courses have required reading respective to their topic: *Acts: The Holy Spirit at Work in the Believer; Prison Epistles: Colossians, Philemon, Ephesians, & Philippians; Romans: Justification by Faith; and Eschatology: A Study of Things to Come.*

Students should plan to read the following books in their devotional time:

Fall Semester:	Acts	Ephesians	Philippians	Colossians	Philemon
Spring Semester:	Romans	Galatians	Revelation	Daniel	

Your journaling will be evaluated at your end of year exit interview. You will be asked to present your journal, however, *your personal content will not be reviewed*. A journaling resource has been provided under the “**Student Resources**” YEAR TWO tab.

10. Attend a Baptism Meeting OR talk to a leader in your local ministry about their process to guide baptism decisions

Satisfies competency 13 of the Intermediate Ministerial Internship

Internal students, go to nr.church/info to consult upcoming events or scroll to the bottom and click the “**LEARN MORE**” bottom to see the full church calendar. External students, consult your ministry leader to learn about their local process.

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11. Attend a Child Dedication Meeting OR talk to a leader in your local ministry about their process to guide child dedications

Satisfies competency 14 of the Intermediate Ministerial Internship

Internal students, go to nr.church/info to consult upcoming events or scroll to the bottom and click the “**LEARN MORE**” bottom to see the full church calendar. External students, consult your ministry leader to learn about their local process.

12. Attend a Coaches Table OR talk with your ministry leader about team and volunteer leadership

Satisfies competencies 3 and 5 of the Intermediate Ministerial Internship

For internal students, go to nr.church/info to consult upcoming events or scroll to the bottom and click the “**LEARN MORE**” bottom to see the full church calendar. External students, consult your ministry leader about the above competencies.

13. Attend an Annual Church Business Meeting

Satisfies competency 4, 6, and 7 of the Intermediate Ministerial Internship

For internal students go to nr.church/info to consult upcoming events or scroll to the bottom and click the “**LEARN MORE**” bottom to see the full church calendar. For external students, attend an annual church business meeting at your local church.

14. Attend or serve at a faith event hosted by a local ministry that is not your own

Satisfies competencies 26 and 28 of the Intermediate Ministerial Internship

Students may participate in church services; prayer, worship, or outreach events. Use this opportunity to explore the wide expressions of ministry happening in Central Wisconsin.

15. Attend or serve at a nonreligious event hosted by a local organization

Satisfies competency 26 and 29 of the Intermediate Ministerial Internship

Research opportunities in your community through your local municipalities. This is an event hosted by a nonreligious local organization. Many choices are available. Students will report to their supervising minister/instructor at their end of year exit interview.

16. Attend an Assemblies of God network event

Satisfies competency 27 of the Intermediate Ministerial Internship

Many opportunities are available for this requirement and require travel. Consider pooling travel with other students. More details are available at WNMDAG.org/events. If event details are missing, call the Wisconsin Northern Michigan Network Office at (715) 258-8118.
