

YEAR 3 INTERNSHIP REQUIREMENTS

In Class Requirements

1. Create a Unique Classroom Prayer Liturgy

Satisfies competencies 2, 9, and 15 of the Advanced Ministerial Internship

Sample liturgies are found at nr.church/nrsm by scrolling down to the “**Student Resources**” section and clicking on the “YEAR THREE” tab. You will be scheduled for this opportunity.

Note: *Unique means you are expected to write and lead prayer in your own words and style. Impromptu prayer is not permitted. No lyrical music tracks may be used. Please submit your written notes to your instructor one week prior to the date to lead.*

2. Participate in all Leadership Timeline Workshops

Satisfies competencies 20, 21, and 24, 36, 37, 38, and 39 of the Advanced Ministerial Internship

Your regular attendance in class is required for this internship competency.

3. Complete and Submit required Leadership Timeline assignments

Satisfies competencies 30, 32, 33, and 35 of the Advanced Ministerial Internship

Assignments are found through nr.church/nrsm by scrolling down to the “**student portal**” and clicking on the “YEAR THREE” tab under Student Resources. Assignments must be completed before class and submitted in class.

4. Attend all NRSM Chapel services

Satisfies competencies 10, 11, 20, 23 and 25 of the Advanced Ministerial Internship

On exam nights, prior to exams all students will attend a chapel led by an NRSM instructor or guest voice on a variety of topics to encourage, enrich, empower, and equip.

Out of Class Requirements

5. Serve regularly on a ministry team

Satisfies competencies 1, 19, 22, 24, and 31 of the Advanced Ministerial Internship

Students are required to serve a minimum of twice per month AND attend required ministry meetings. Year 3 are expected to work with your ministry leader to partner in leadership and communication during the course of the year.

6. Create and share a training, teaching, or preach a sermon with a prayer response in your ministry service area

Satisfies competencies 8, 16, and 17 of the Advanced Ministerial Internship

Work with your ministry leader to contribute content in an environment appropriate to your role in the ministry. This could be a leader meeting, regular service, or small group.

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7. Participate on a team or in an event that allows you to minister to people unfamiliar to the gospel

Satisfies competency 12 of the Advanced Ministerial Internship

Several options are available to complete this competency. If an opportunity is not listed, please consult your instructor for approval. If one of the events below requires time away from the classroom, please provide that date to your relevant instructor so that an excused absence may be provided.

8. Arrange a spring semester 1:1 Pastoral Meeting with a North Ridge Church Pastor to review your leadership timeline

Satisfies competency 30, 35, 36, 37, 38, and 39 of the Advanced Ministerial Internship

All students will be required to review their completed Leadership Timelines with a pastor on staff at North Ridge Church. Students should expect to discuss their personal histories, phases experienced, and imagined futures. This meeting can be arranged by contacting the office administrator at info@nr.chruch.

9. Activate one of the NRSM prayer liturgies once a month in your private prayer time and keep a prayer journal recording how it did or did not affect you

Satisfies competency 34 of the Advanced Ministerial Internship

All prayer liturgies are found through nr.church/nrsm by scrolling down to the “**student portal**” and clicking on the “YEAR THREE” tab under Student Resources.

Your journaling will be evaluated at your end of year exit interview. You will be asked to present your journal, however, *your personal content will not be reviewed*. A journaling resource has been provided under the “**Student Resources**” YEAR THREE tab.

10. Participate in a Baptism Service

Satisfies competency 13 of the Advanced Ministerial Internship

Internal students will pastorally welcome and direct baptism candidates as they arrive at a Family Celebration service. Go to nr.church/info to consult upcoming events or scroll to the bottom and click the “**LEARN MORE**” bottom to see the full church calendar. Please contact the office administrator at info@nr.chruch to be included in the event.

External students should consult their local ministry leader for ways to be involved in an upcoming service.

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11. Participate in a Child Dedication Service

Satisfies competency 14 of the Advanced Ministerial Internship

Internal students will pastorally welcome and direct child dedication candidates as they arrive at a Family Celebration service. Go to nr.church/info to consult upcoming events or scroll to the bottom and click the “**LEARN MORE**” button to see the full church calendar. Please contact the office administrator at info@nr.church to be included in the event.

External students should consult their local ministry leader for ways to be involved in an upcoming service.

12. Solve & Submit a Benevolence Case Study

Satisfies competency 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 of the Advanced Ministerial Internship

Students will be required to produce a solution to a church benevolence issue. The details of this assignment are found at nr.church/nrsm by scrolling down to the “**Student Resources**” section and clicking on the “YEAR THREE” tab.

13. Serve at a faith event hosted by a local ministry that is not your own

Satisfies competencies 26 and 28 of the Intermediate Ministerial Internship

Students may participate in church services; prayer, worship, or outreach events. Use this opportunity to explore the wide expressions of ministry happening in Central Wisconsin.

14. Serve at a nonreligious event hosted by a local organization

Satisfies competency 26 and 29 of the Intermediate Ministerial Internship

Research opportunities in your community through your local municipalities. This is an event hosted by a nonreligious local organization. Many choices are available. Students will report to their supervising minister/instructor at their end of year exit interview.

15. Attend an Assemblies of God network event

Satisfies competency 27 of the Advanced Ministerial Internship

Many opportunities are available for this requirement and require travel. Consider pooling travel with other students. More details are available at WNMDAG.org/events. If event details are missing, call the Wisconsin Northern Michigan Network Office at (715) 258-8118.
