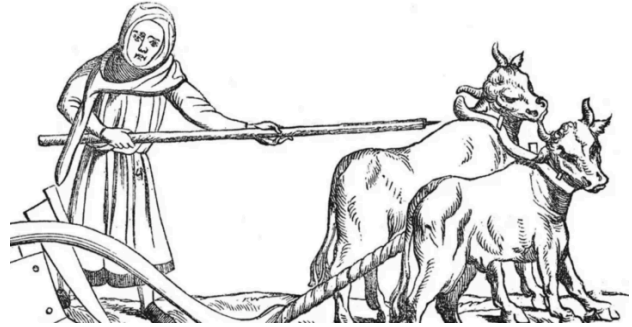
It was mentioned in the Teacher Video that Jesus taught with authority and his life. Why was this shocking to those that listened to him? Why might this shock people today?

In Mark 12:30 (NIV), Jesus said, “*Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.*” How might this text contrast the Shepherd and the Teacher. How are they different, how are they similar?

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Still thinking about the Shepherd and the Teacher, read Ecclesiastes 12:9-11 (NIV), see Ecclesiastes 12:11 for clarity to answer the following question. The role of the Shepherd (you will learn more detail later) has been described to work with a rod and staff and here the role of the Teacher works with a goad, what does this text tell us about the work of a teacher?
