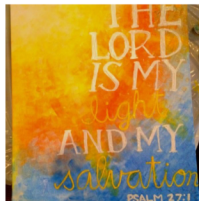

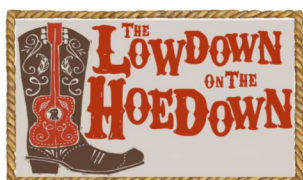
Paint and Pray the psalms
