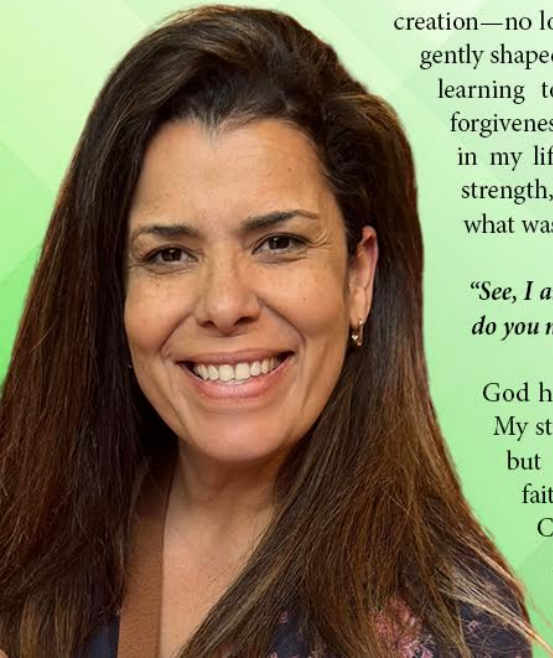

One of my greatest regrets is breaking my youngest daughter's heart after she had already lost her father and was looking to me for stability. She is one of the strongest people I know—a true fighter whose resilience inspires me every day. Today, I am a proud mother of three incredible children, and I look forward to rebuilding our family in new ways, one day at a time, through God's grace.

I came with nothing and was given a One Year Bible. Looking back, I realize it was everything I needed.

Over the past year, God's Word has healed me, confronted me, corrected me, and transformed me. Through His grace, I have become a new creation—no longer defined by who I was, but being gently shaped into who He is calling me to be. I am learning to walk in freedom, to rest in His forgiveness, and to trust His work of restoration in my life. 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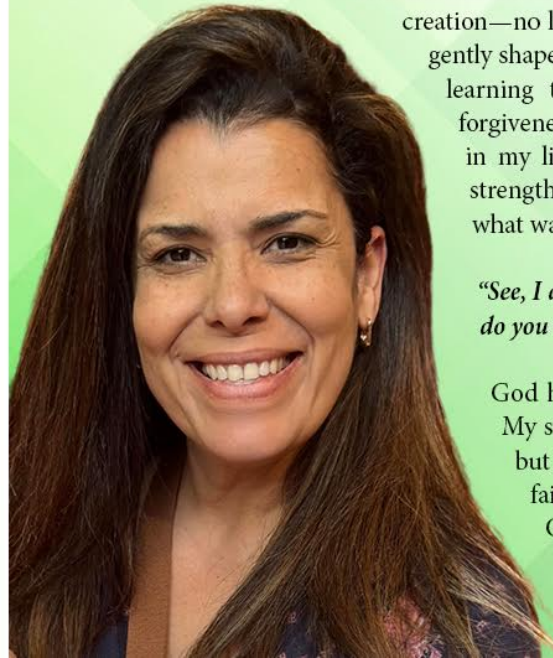
