A NOTE FROM PASTOR TRAVIS



“How do I become a church member?” is the gist of the question that I was asked not too long ago. What would you say to someone that might ask you that same question? The question made me think about the “power of simple” when it comes to what is needed to be saved. Thankfully, I was able to go right back to the basics of what Jesus tells us in Scripture about knowing Him and knowing that we will have eternal life, which is the simple essence of what is needed to be a church member.

My kindergarten teacher, Mrs. Collins, started with the basics, or the foundations, for learning math. She didn’t start with complex, algebraic equations. Rather, she started with the basics. Knowing the basics, like simple addition and subtraction, never changes. It’s “the power of simple” that carries over into knowing Jesus personally in a saving relationship.

On Easter Sunday morning, in all three of our services, we are going to look at what Jesus tells us in John chapter 11 as He interacted with Martha after the passing of her brother, Lazarus.

Jesus pointed out the basics in what He said to her: belief in Him, and belief in His resurrection are required from us. Here’s what He declared in verses 25-26: “Jesus said to her, I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me, even if he dies, will live. Everyone who lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?”

The very mission of our church is to connect people to a saving relationship with the Lord Jesus and with His Church, and on Easter Sunday I’m going to preach on “The Power of Simple.”

Easter Sunday is a fantastic time for each one of us to invite someone that is not connected to a local church, and more importantly, not connected to Jesus. Be praying about who you can invite to one of our three services on Easter Sunday!
