A NOTE FROM PASTOR BRUNO



Graduation season is here, and it carries real weight — 18 years of love, struggle, memories, and hardship. The moment parents watch babies step into adulthood; for many students, the season when their faith becomes their own. That is a BIG DEAL.

But here is what I love: graduation ceremonies are called commencement ceremonies. Commencement means to begin. What looks like an ending, is actually a start.

And the world our graduates are beginning to step into? It is loud. It moves fast. It is constantly trying to redirect attention and redefine the path. It functions like a GPS — always recalculating, always rerouting. The danger is that whoever controls the signal controls where you end up. If we let culture control the signal, culture sets the destination.

The Christian life is much more like following a compass. A compass always tells you where True North is. It works when phones lose signal, when satellites go dark, when the grid stops. You may not know exactly where you are — but you always know exactly where True North is. And for followers of Jesus, that is enough to take the next step.

Ephesians 2:10 says we are God's *workmanship* — created in Christ Jesus for good works He prepared ahead of time for us to walk in. The Greek word behind "workmanship" is *poiema*, where we get our English word "poem." You are not an accident. You are a crafted work — authored by God with purpose already written into you. That is your True North.

First, we have to **Consecrate** ourselves — offering ourselves, as Romans 12:1 calls us, as living sacrifices — set apart not from the world, but for something greater. From that foundation, we **Cultivate** — through Scripture, community, and faithfulness in ordinary moments. And from what we cultivate, we **Create** — making things that reflect His goodness from the workplace to the nations, going into all the world and making disciples who point back to King Jesus.

Church family, with Senior Recognition Sunday coming up on May 17th, here is my pastoral encouragement to you: The culture will always attempt to redirect us, so live by the compass. You were created on purpose, for a purpose, by a God who does not recalculate — He is the same yesterday, today, and forever. Let's cheer the Class of 2026 on and be praying for them, together!
