Historical Significance:

1. The name means “circle” and lies to the east and northeast of the Sea of Galilee. It is 45 miles long and 16 miles wide.
2. This area was assigned to the tribe of Manasseh.
3. This is a strategic area for the defense of Israel.
4. Mt. Hermon is located here. It overlooks the Sea of Galilee and the Hula Valley.
