

**Site:** Hezekiah's Tunnel

**Scripture References:** 2 Kings 20:20; 2 Chronicles 32: 3-4, 7-8, 30; Isaiah 22:10; John 9: 1-11

**Historical Significance:**

1. The tunnel was built by King Hezekiah in preparation for the assault by the Assyrian army. It was discovered in 1838.

**Things to look for:**

1. A copy of the Siloam inscription that tells how the tunneling crews could hear each other shout as the two excavating teams got close together.

2. Traditional Pool of Siloam built by Christians in the fifth century to recall the miracle of Jesus healing the man who was blind from birth.

**What does this site teach us about God?**
